RE: Job Shadow Day at NASA Wallops Flight Facility

On Monday, February 2, 2015, NASA Wallops Flight Facility (WFF) will hold its third Job Shadow Day. This day is designed to provide students with a career exploration experience with NASA WFF and NASA's missions. Students interested in participating must be recommended by school administration or teachers in specific subject areas. Only US citizens may apply due to the short timeframe and necessary badging requirements. Students must be 16 years old by February 1, 2015. Any student recommended and wishing to participate must complete the information requested as well as an essay (150 -200 words) that begins, "This experience at Wallops Flight Facility will help me...."

This is considered a field trip. All school rules apply and transportation to and from WFF is the responsibility of the student or school system. Students will be informed of the need for specialized clothing (outdoor work clothing possible) if selected.

The day will begin at the badging office at 8:00 am. After badging, students will then report to E-2 (cafeteria) at 8:30 am for an introduction to Wallops and the events for the day. Students will meet their mentors and leave for their morning session from 9:00 am - 11:30 am. Students will return to the cafeteria for lunch (lunch is not provided but will be available in the Wallops cafeteria approximately \$6 - \$10). Lunch will include a presentation on internship opportunities at Wallops. Students will attend their afternoon assignments from 12:30 pm - 3:00 pm. Students will return to the cafeteria for a brief wrap-up and depart Wallops no later than 3:15 pm. In the event of inclement weather and a cancellation on February 2nd, a back-up date of February 9th has been established.
