TO PARENTS OF ELEMENTARY (TK-4) STUDENTS: WHAT TO DO IF...

YOU HAVE A CONCERN: Call Dena Blomster, Office Manager at 336-2822 Ext. 4010 for assistance.

YOU WANT TO TALK/LEAVE A MESSAGE WITH A TEACHER: Call the elementary school (336-2822) and during the recording, dial the staff member's extension. (See back of this sheet for teachers or refer to the Spirit Lake School website @ www.spirit-lake.k12.ia.us for specific staff member's extension numbers that are not listed.) You will be able to talk directly to the staff member or leave a message on their voicemail.

YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT: Call the school (336-2822) prior to 8:20 A.M. and leave a message on your child's teacher's voicemail. If your child is absent and we have not heard from you or do not know why your child is absent, we will attempt to call you at home or at work. Please make sure we have your current contact information on file. It is extremely important that we are able to contact you as needed, not only for absences, but also in emergency situations. You may also make arrangements for homework by dialing the teacher's extension during the recording.

YOU WANT TO LEAVE A MESSAGE FOR YOUR CHILD: Please call the teacher before 12:00 P.M. to get a message to the teacher directly. You may also call the office before 2:30 P.M. to get a message to your child. We try not to interrupt classes unless it is an emergency, however your message will be delivered before the end of the day. If the message isn't into the office by 2:30, we will do our best to deliver that message but there are no guarantees due to how busy dismissal time can be.

YOU HAVE A CONCERN ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, OR EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT: Dial the extension of your child's teacher, school nurse, counselor, or principal.

PARENT VISITS: We are proud of our elementary school and elementary programs. We encourage you to visit our building. We ask that you contact your child's teacher in advance to make arrangements.

<u>PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES</u>: Formal parent-teacher conferences are scheduled in November and March each school year. Formal conferences are also scheduled for parents of preschool – TK and KG students at the beginning of the school year. Parents may request a conference with their child's teacher, counselor, nurse, or principal at any time throughout the school year.

TRAFFIC PATTERNS: Parents are able to use two areas to pick up and drop off students at Spirit Lake Elementary. Before school, parents may either use the North or West parking lots. After 8:20 A.M., entry to the building will be limited to the West entrance; all other doors to the building will be locked.

To dismiss or pick up your child, we have a dismissal routine to alleviate traffic jams. The dismissal routine can be viewed by typing <u>https://goo.gl/fykSZV</u> (case sensitive) into your internet browser. To ensure there is always a steady flow of traffic, there will be no parking during dismissal time.

The bus lane which is located just south of the Elementary and Middle School will be only for bus loading and unloading.

Dismissal Routine at SLES

After reviewing ALICE procedures, the elementary building is continuing to further implement safety procedures. This includes a buzz in system and a dismissal routine. The following describes the dismissal routine at the end of the day:

- 1) I encourage no parents to enter the building to pick up their children. The buzz in system will prevent anyone from entering the building without office staff's knowledge.
- 2) Students who will be picked up will be hand delivered to the vehicles by classroom teachers. Due to the doors being locked, students will be meeting parents outside in designated pickup areas. In order to accommodate these changes, some dismissal times have been adjusted and designated pickup areas have been assigned. The new procedure is as follows:

Dismissal Times/Pick up Area Preschool: 3:10 North Lot next to PK playground. Kindergarten: 3:15 North West Door 1st Grade: 3:15 West Parking Lot 2nd Grade: 3:20 West Parking Lot 3rd Grade: 3:15 West Parking Lot 4th Grade: 3:15 West Parking Lot

PK will now be picked up closer to the PK playground (11/29/17)



3) Families with multiple students will be asked to pick up in the youngest students designated area. The older siblings will be sent to the classroom of the younger sibling in order to walk out with them to the designated area.

4) To pick up, please be cautious due to the amount of children present. On either side of the building, there will be lanes painted to help with the logistics of traffic. There is a drive through lane and a pick up lane. You will drive through, pull into the pick up lane to pick up you child or children. If the class isn't to their designated area by the time you arrive, <u>please do not stop and wait.</u> There will be no parking in either lane, drive through lane or pick up lane. In order for pick up to go smoothly, we need to avoid parked cars outside of designated parking spots.

5) If there is a change to who is picking up your child/children, please be sure to notify the office or the classroom teacher.
