

Dear Parents & Guardians,

We are requesting the honor or having your child participate in a celebration of the arts night, "Governor Wolf's ART & SOUL," March 31st, 2017. Take advantage of being able to show the public his/her great talent! If your child chooses to participate, preparation of the activity will occur outside of the regular school day. Your child can choose to work with a partner, be part of a small group, or do something by him/herself.

This year we are also allowing a chance for students to be seen whose talents require being outdoors to participate. These participants would need to meet the following requirements: 1. Have a talent that MUST be done outside. Examples include but are not limited to ice skating, skateboarding, motocross bike riding, equestrian/horse riding, etc. 2. Be able to provide a 30 second to one and a half minute digitally recorded video clip of them performing the talent. 3. Receive approval.

The following are some suggested ideas for activities, and we look forward to any creative ideas of your own. Students can develop their own original presentations of the following: poetry, short stories, original dramatic readings, original music composition, dance presentations and displays. Children may use mediums of creativity including pictures, motocross or tricks done while skateboarding. We will consider other activities as well as long as they CAN NOT be preformed indoors.

If interested, please assist your child in completing the form being sent home. The form ALONG WITH THE CD containing any necessary music (no longer than two and a half minutes). Please form MUST be handed in by Friday Feb. 17th so I can start burning the music and making the pamphlet. Calling all 5th graders: We are looking for a few students to emcee this event.

There will be four MANDATORY rehearsals for the show on March 15th, 22nd, and 29th beginning at 5:30 pm. Students must attend these rehearsals in order to participate. **Also children may not be dropped off.
