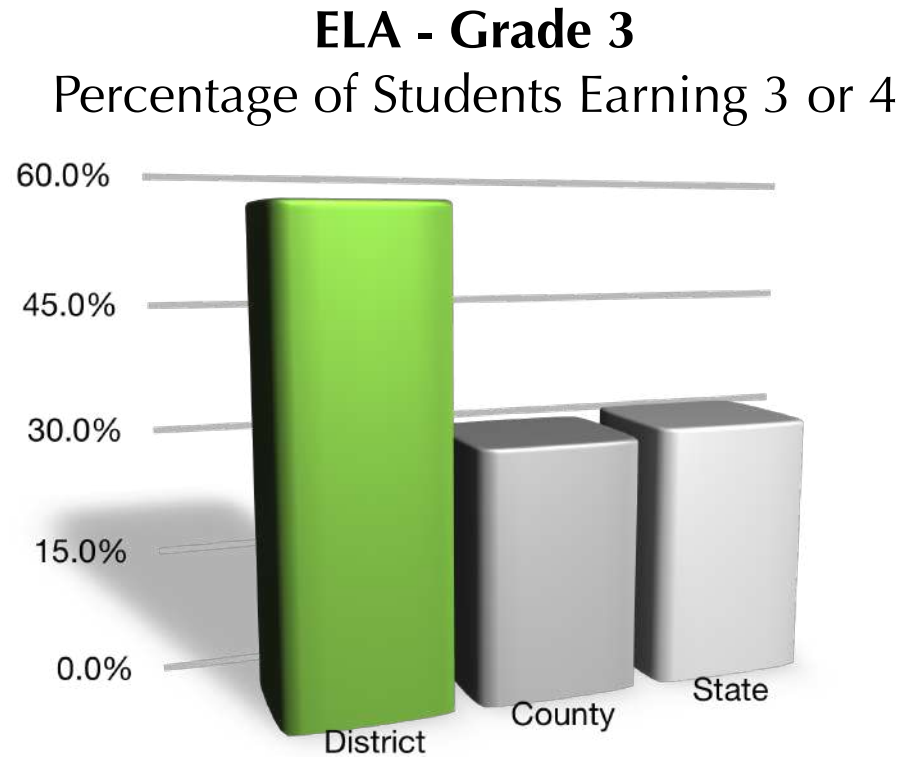

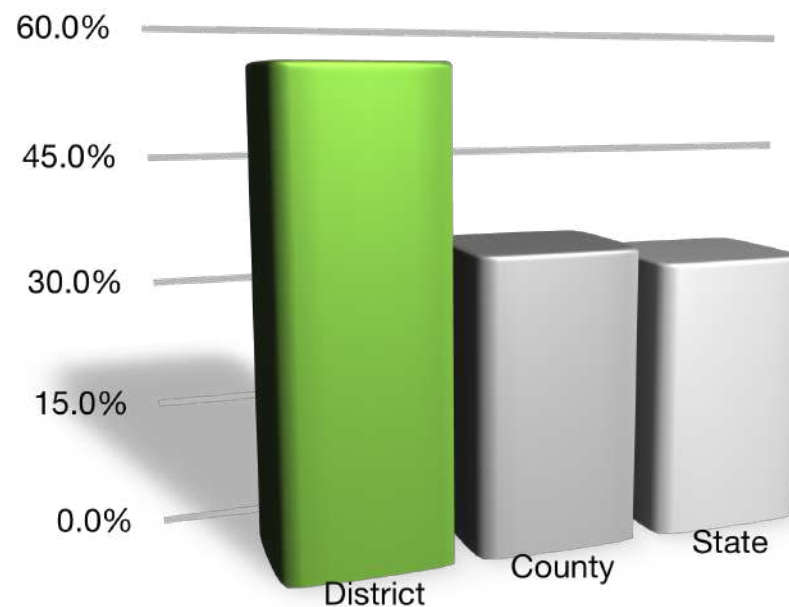

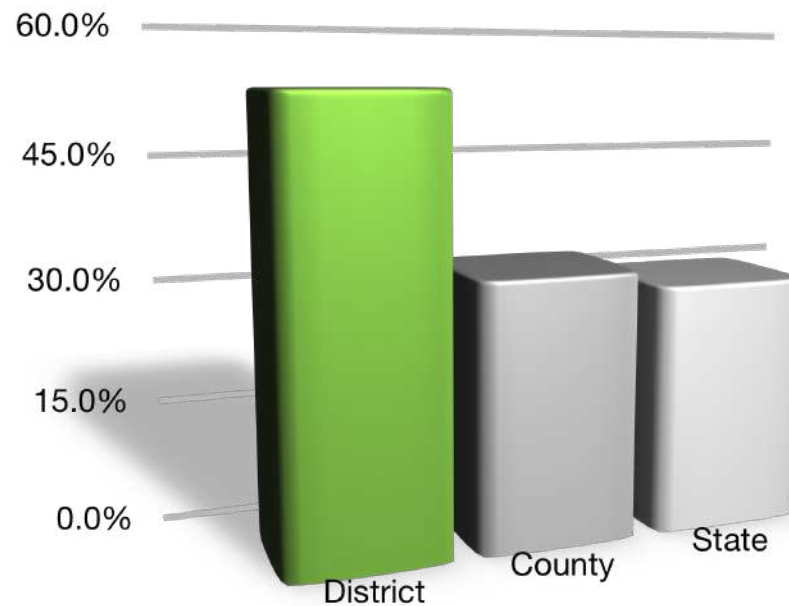

ELA - Grade 4 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



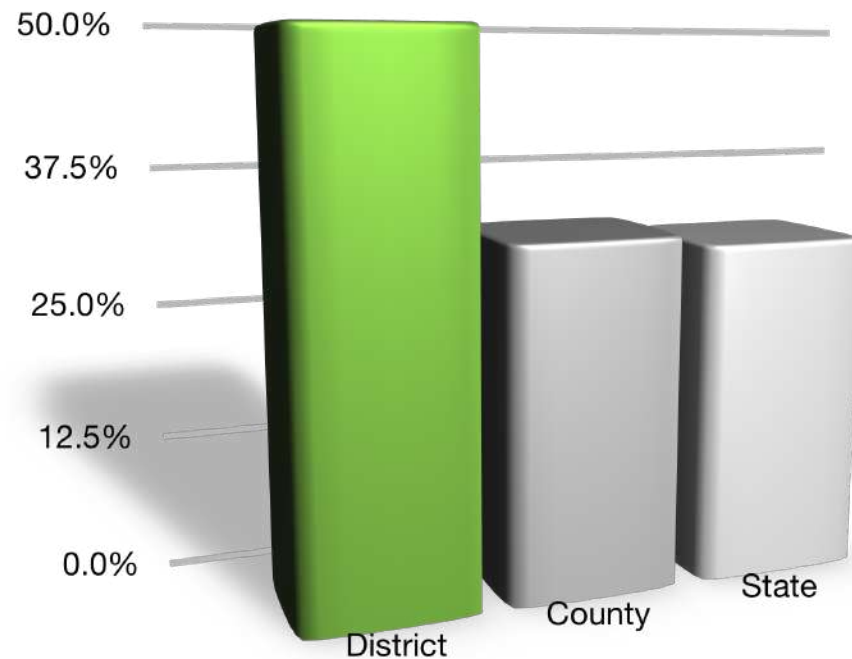

ELA - Grade 5 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



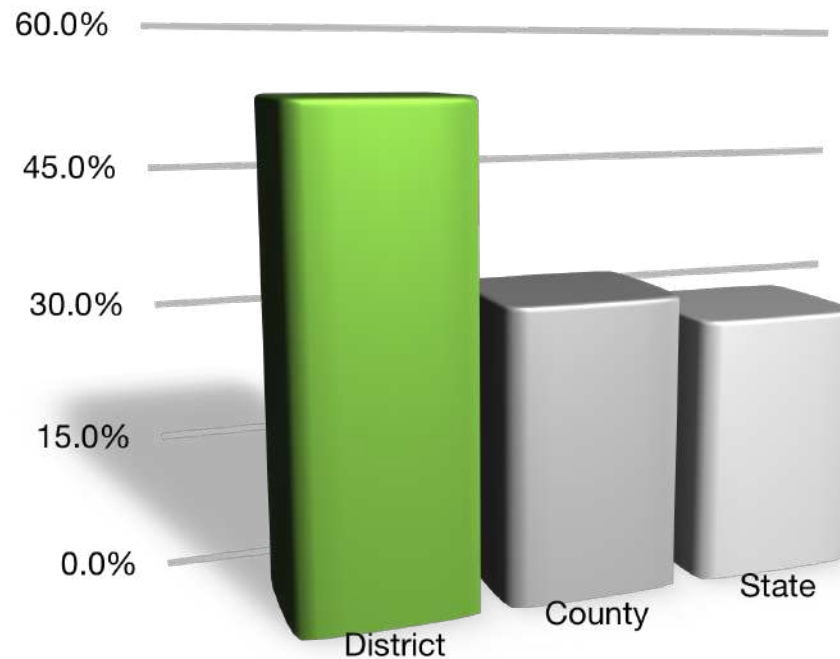

ELA - Grade 6 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



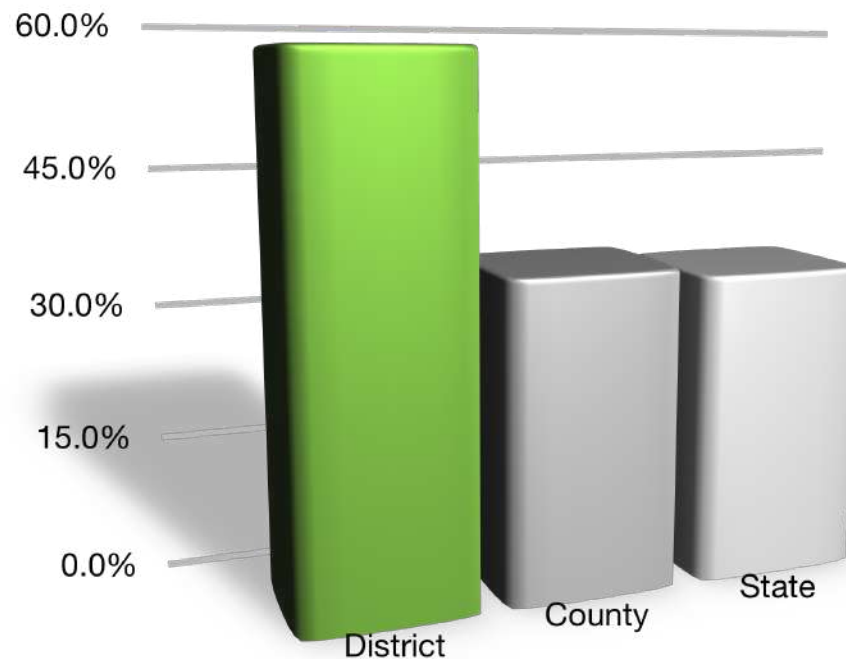

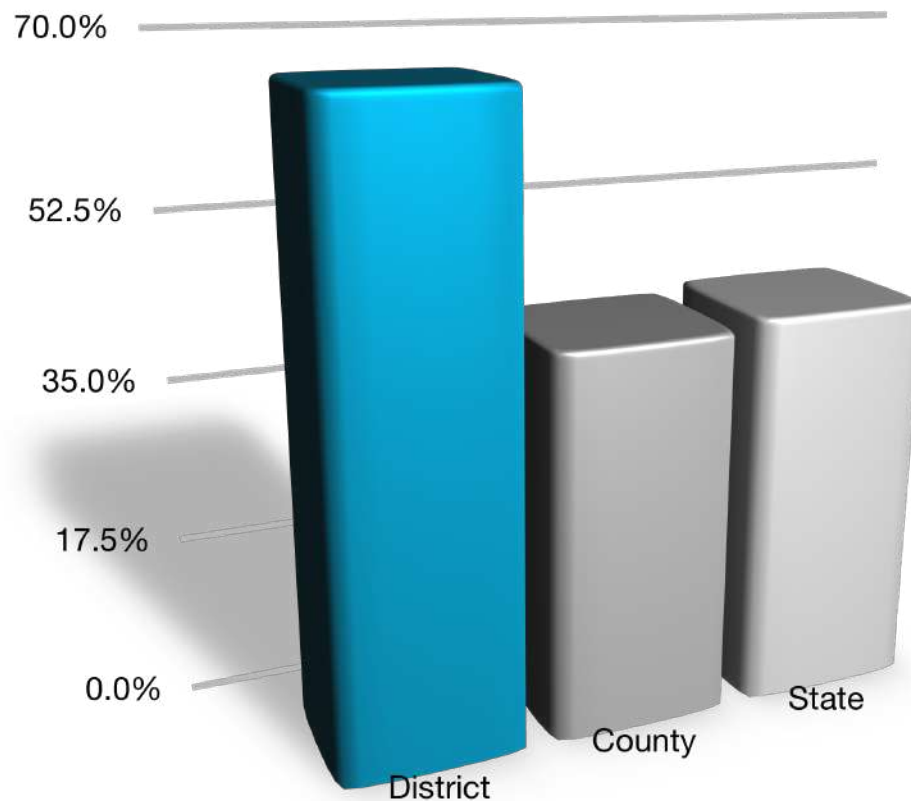

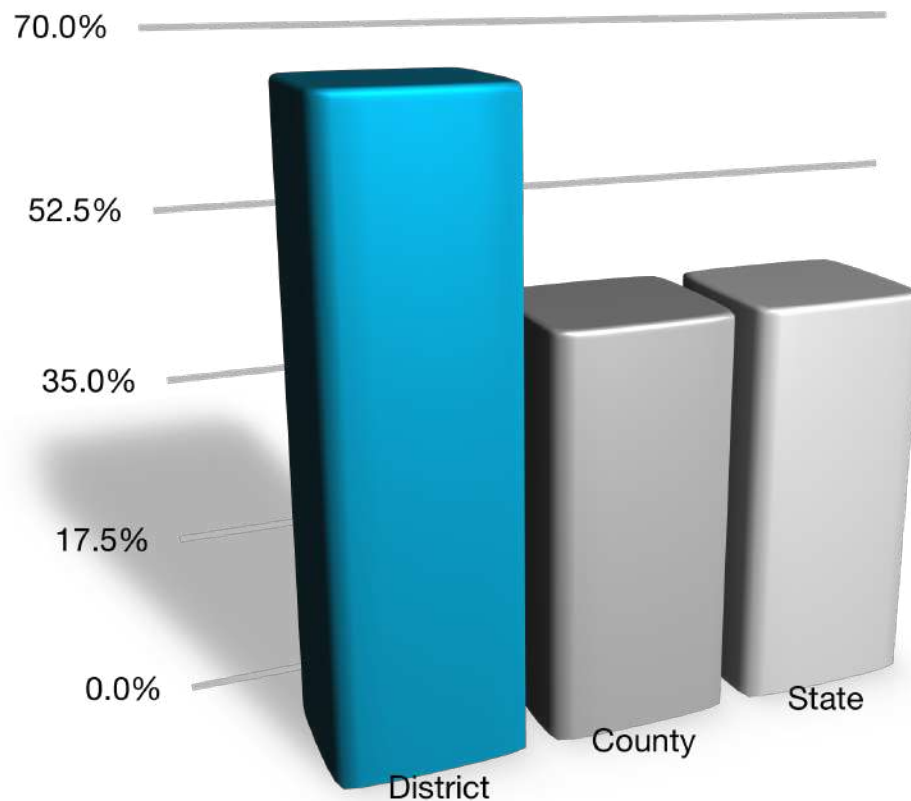

Mathematics - Grade 3 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



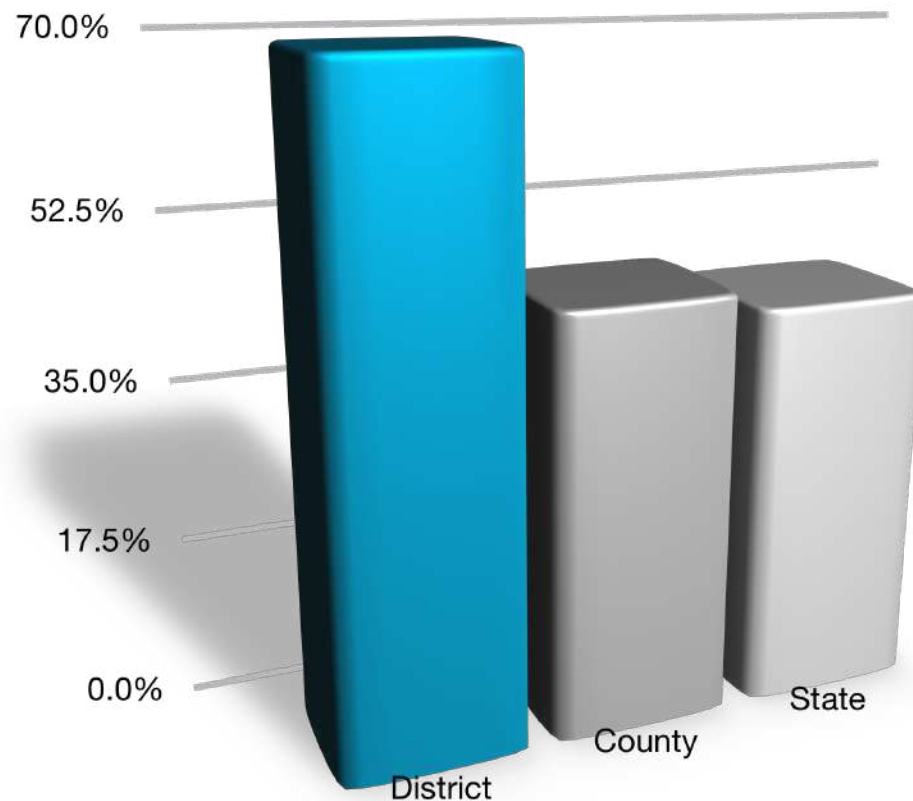

Mathematics - Grade 4 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



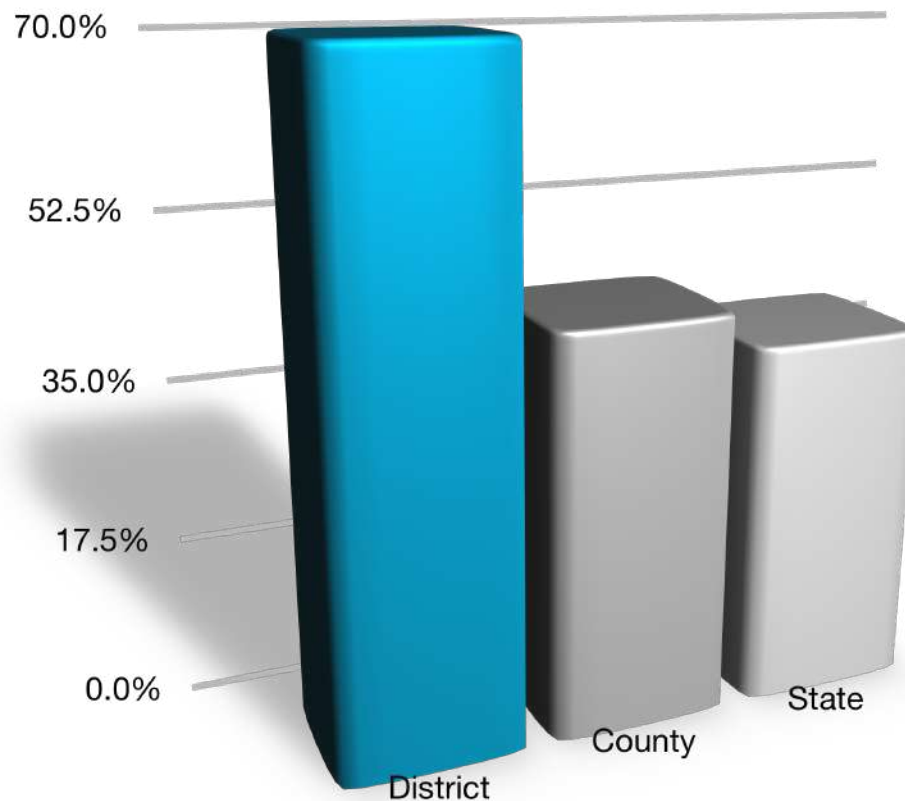

Mathematics - Grade 5 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



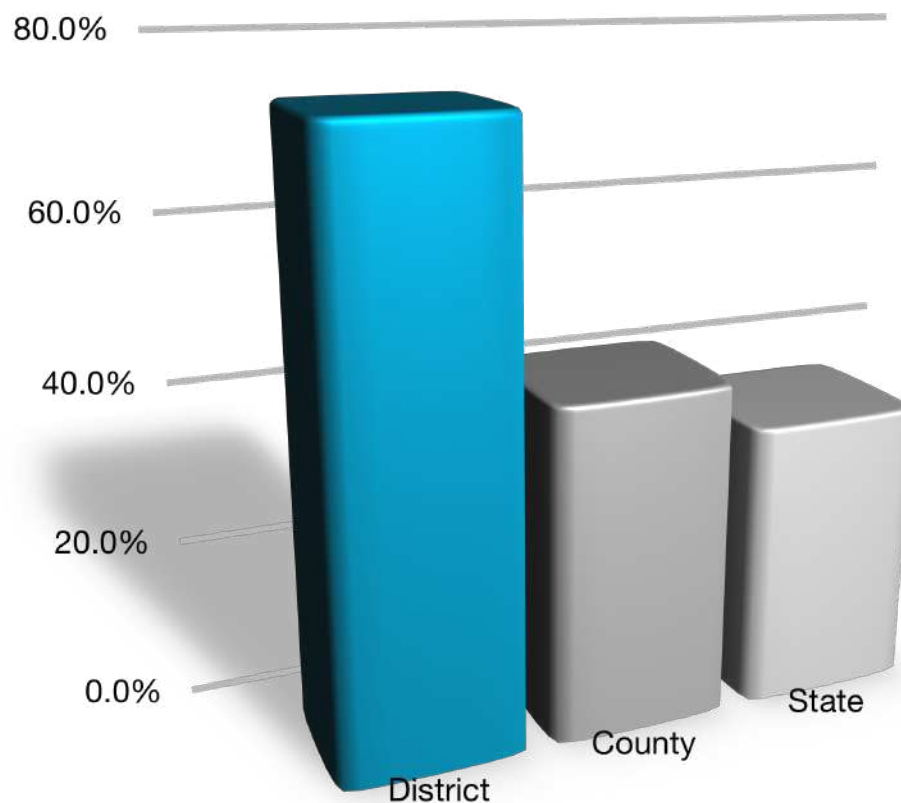

Mathematics - Grade 6 Percentage of Students Earning 3 or 4



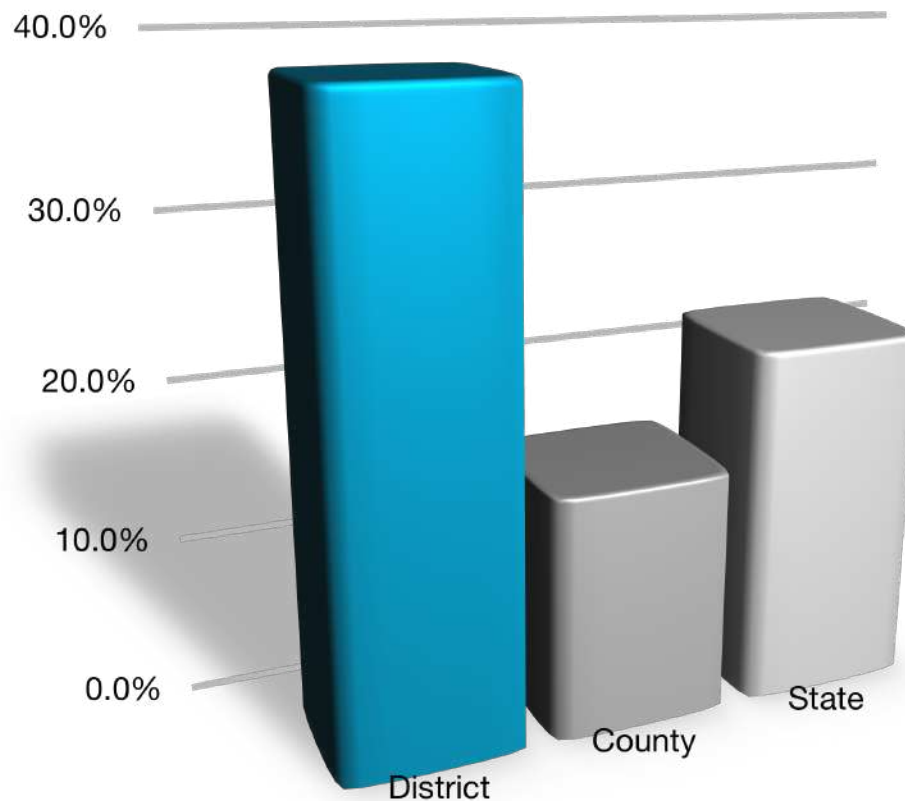

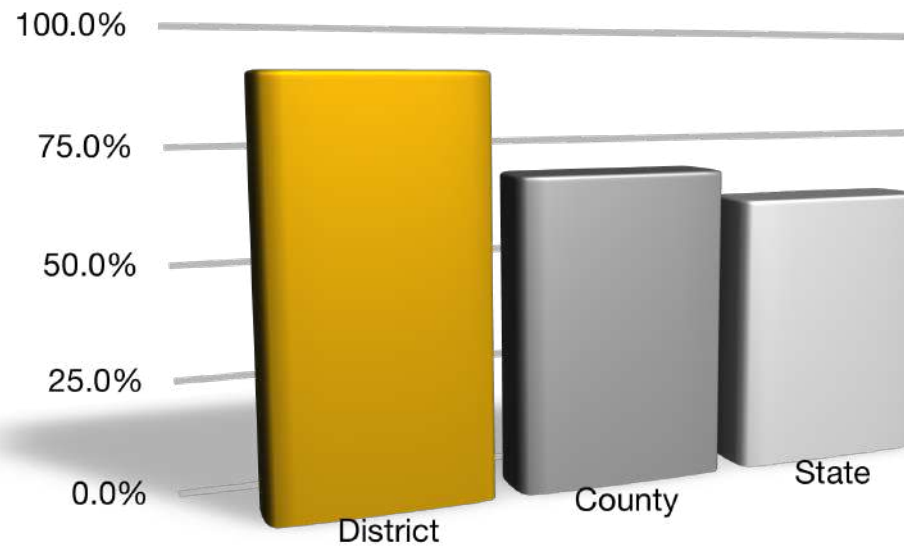

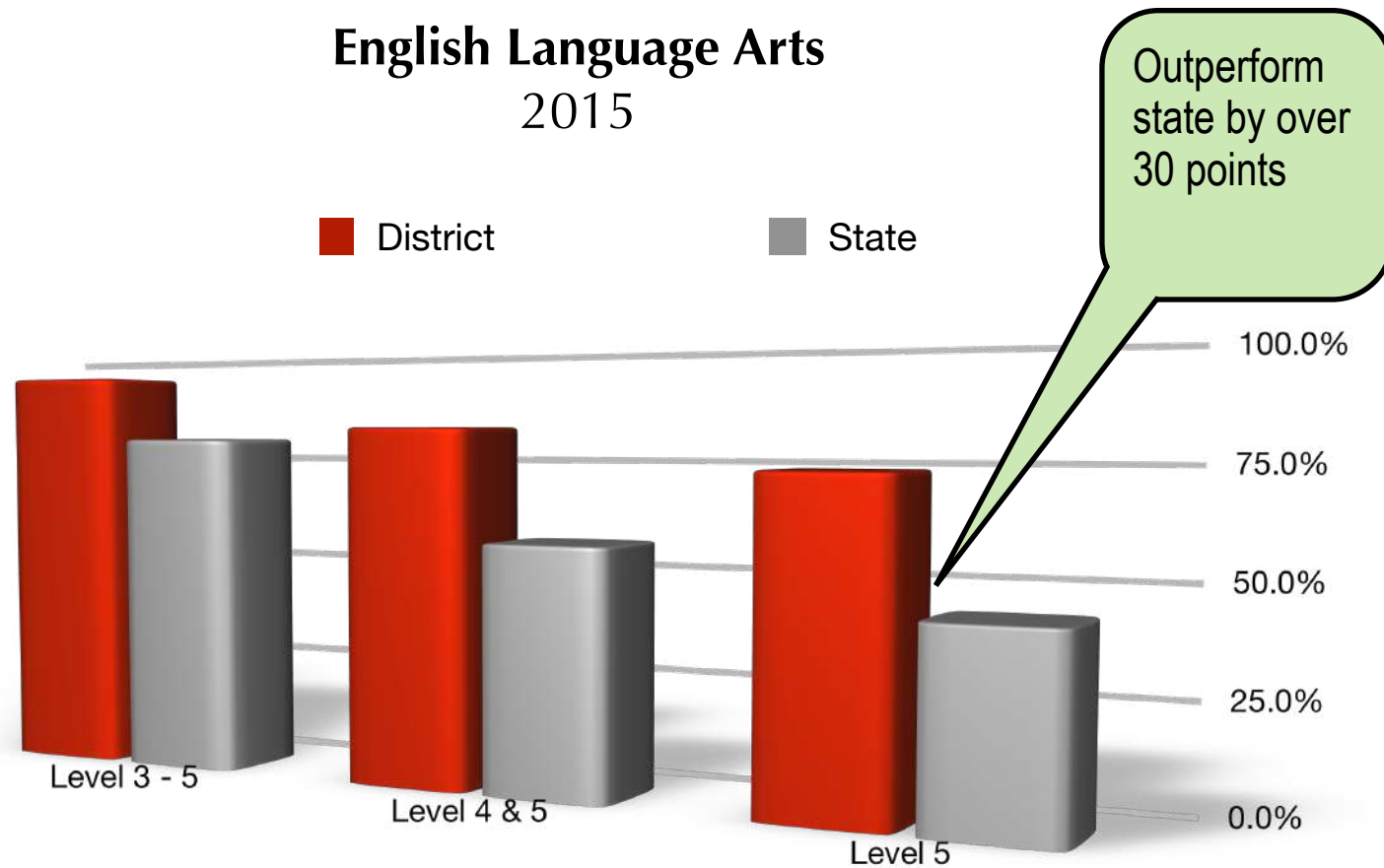

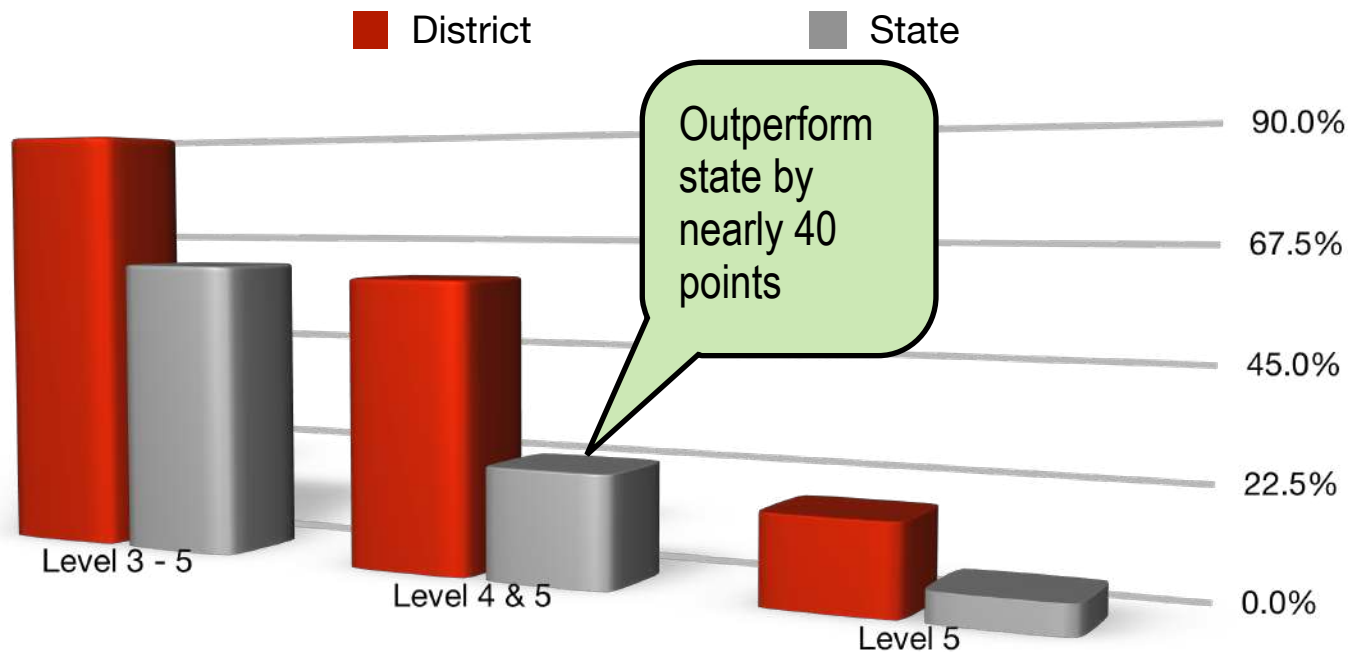

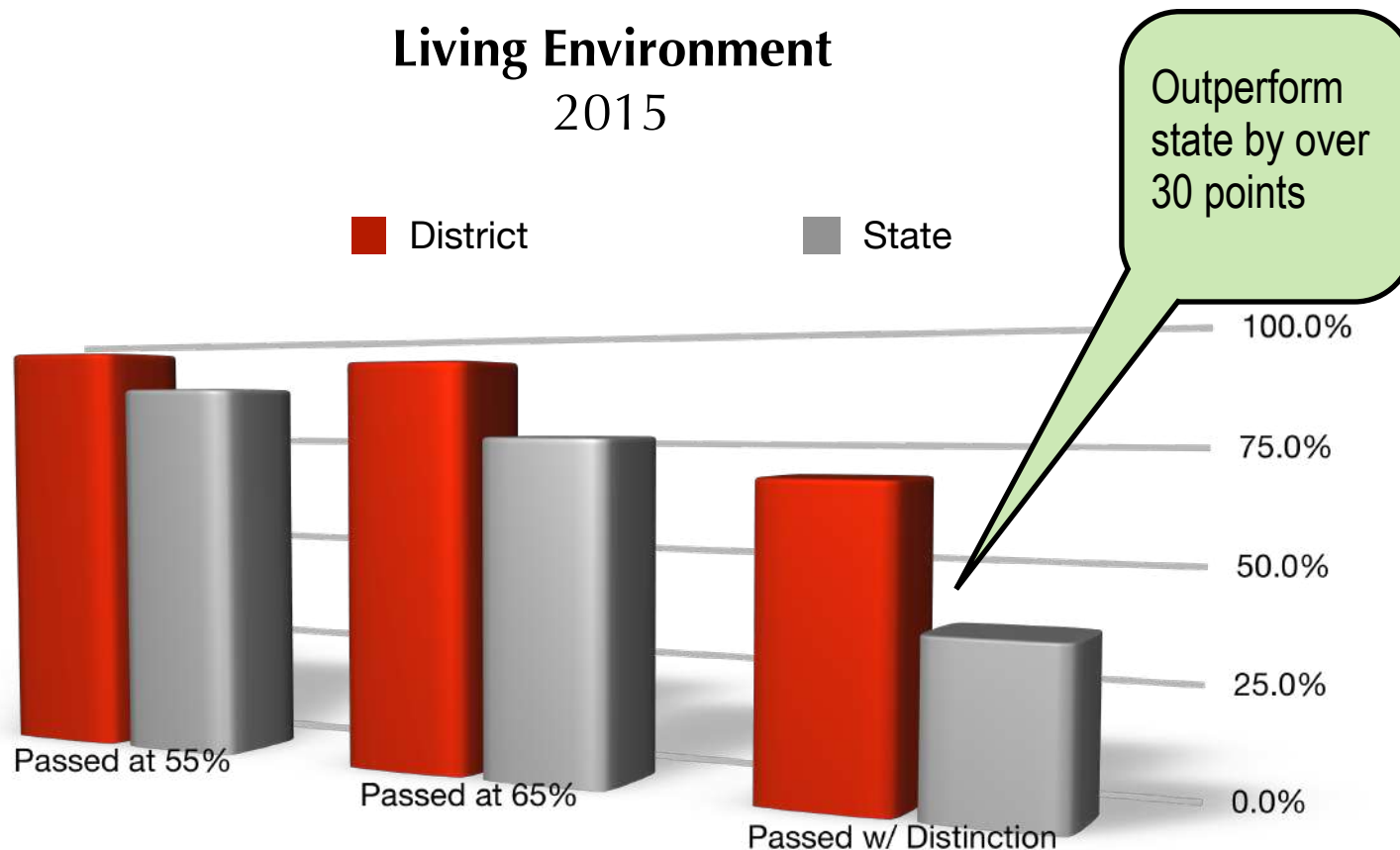

Over 25% of all students tested achieved a score of 5

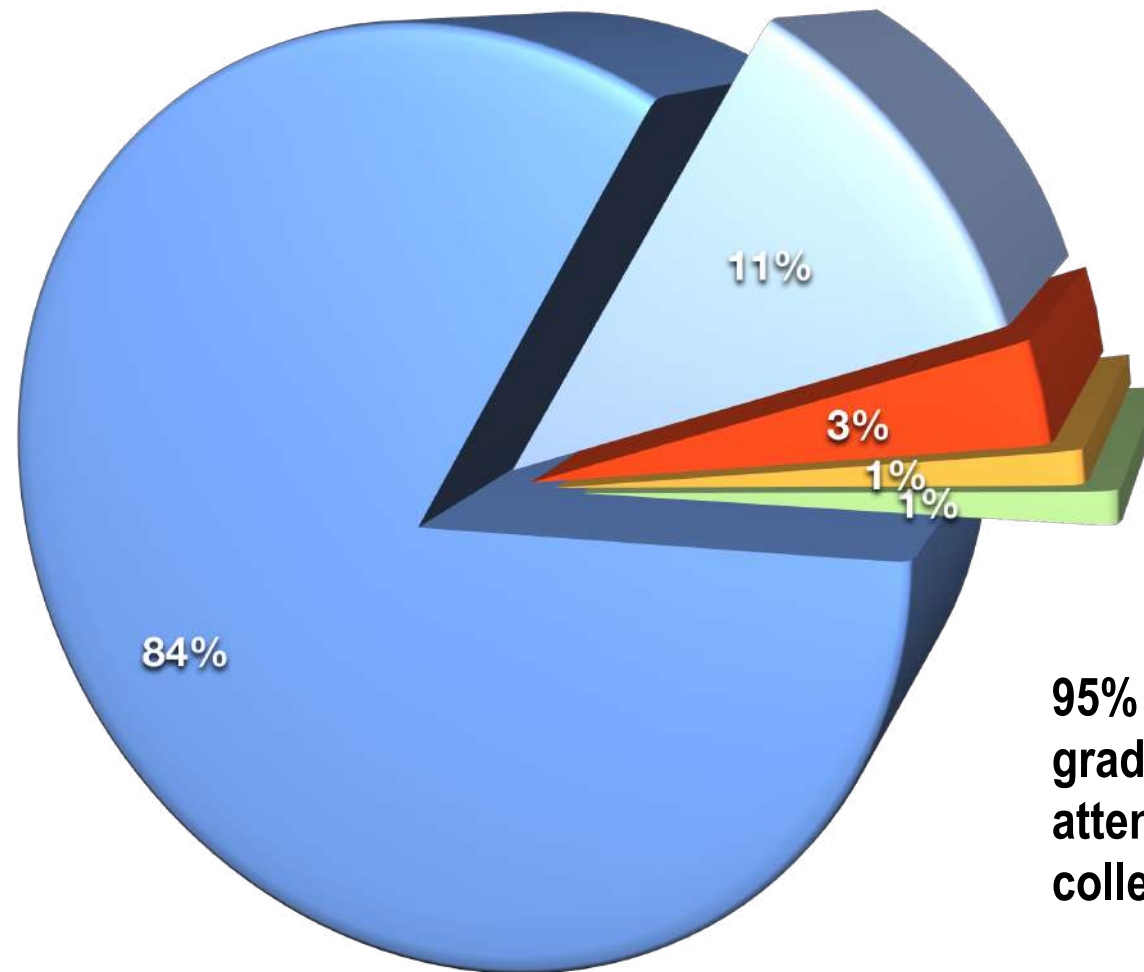

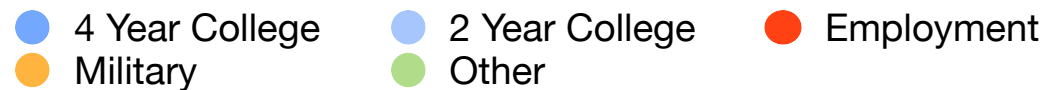
