### **Final Transcripts for Seniors**

All post-secondary institutions will require a FINAL transcript with student's final semester grades and their graduation date. Transcripts are typically ready to go the week of June 24. An email will be sent to all seniors and their parents/guardians when they are finalized. If you need to send an *official copy* to a post-secondary institution, NCAA, the military or employer, please request this through **PARCHMENT**. You may do this now but remember to click "hold for grades" so we know to wait to send it. *All requests must go through Parchment to be considered official* at <a href="https://www.parchment.com/">https://www.parchment.com/</a>.
