
Handcoloring examples

Historical and in Photoshop

Handcolored Photos

Since photographs were historically in black in white, people would take actual paint to add color after a photo was printed.

You can often tell that a photo has been handcolored because the shadows remain black and the colors are simple thin washes of solid colors.




For this assignment, you will do the following:
