# **Hope You Had a Wonderful Summer!**

Please click the image below to read a message from Principal Donaghy. Students will receive a student signature sheet in homeroom for you to sign and return by next Friday. All other fees are due October 1st for underclassmen and November 1st for Seniors.

Administrators assist students in finding a seat in the cafeteria for the first few days at lunches. Students are not assigned a place and can sit where they are comfortable. They can change their seat as many times as they wish. The Juniors and Seniors eat together in the West Commons and the Freshmen and Sophomores eat together in the East Commons. This year 15 additional tables have been added, providing seats for every student in the cafeteria. Students may also eat in the library if they feel they want a quieter academic setting to eat lunch. It takes about five to seven minutes for students to find a place to sit. The freshmen are called down to lunch a few minutes earlier than the rest of the population. If your student has difficulty finding a place to sit, please direct them to see an adult in the lunchroom for assistance. There are plenty of adults willing to help in and out in the lunchroom all day, every day at HHS!

#### **Delaware County Community College Dual Enrollment**

What is Dual Enrollment?

The College's Dual Enrollment Program provides eligible high school students the opportunity to earn college credits while they're still in high school at a fraction of the standard tuition rates. Interested high school students are invited to apply and participants are selected based on demonstrated academic ability and motivation. Accepted high school students can take a maximum of 21 credits at the Dual Enrollment discounted price.

If you have been experiencing issues with the app, please follow the below steps.

The steps to perform this refresh are:

- 1. Open the SchoolMessenger app.
- 2. Go to the menu in the upper left corner.
- 3. Choose contacts.
- 4. Once in contacts, press the refresh button in the upper right-hand corner.

- 5. This screen will still show an error, but when you open the menu from the upper left the second time, you will have access to Attendance. Messages will also be populated with all recent messages you were sent.
- 6. At this point, your app should be functioning normally again.
