# **Car Rider Arrival Updates and Reminders**

We have noticed several patterns in the morning car-rider drop-off line that merit attention.

- 1. Please **be completely "mindful"** (cognitively present!) when driving through the car-rider arrival line.
- 2. Please be as early as possible—7:15-7:30 is best!
- 3. Please **obey directions of staffers** or volunteers at all times—especially pulling forward till the last available slot.
- 4. Please **stay off your cellphones** in the drop-off zone—including hands-free devices.
- 5. Please **say goodbyes BEFORE the drop-off zone** (like at the airport—goodbyes are usually before security checkpoints, not at the gate!)
- 6. Please don't drive up onto the curb! (See #1 above)
- 7. Please **avoid the "long wave goodbye,"** and/or talking to your children as they're walking along the sidewalk alongside the vehicle. This is dangerous, as students usually pay attention to their loved ones, but should be attending to getting off the curb, and walking safely into the building.
- 8. Please **have children prepared to open their own door** and disembark as soon as you're directed to a complete stop within the drop-off zone. We unload about 18 cars each round, but do not have 18 staffers to open doors. Also, most children should be independent in this task by this point in the year. You do not have to wait until your door is opened to disembark.
- 9. Please remember that students must be **in their classrooms** at the 7:45 bell to avoid being tardy.
- 10. Please make sure not to park in specially-marked parking spaces when visiting, unless you qualify for those spaces (an active and prominently displayed handicapped tag, for instance).

Please help us to make arrival as safe and efficient as possible. Everyone will benefit. Thanks!

#### AM Processes, lunch processes, dismissal processes—status update

- 2:00 pm dismissal deadline: **Early dismissals are not allowed after 2:00 pm**. After 2:00 pm, students must follow the regular dismissal process.
- If you walk your child(ren) into the building, we now ask that parents say their "goodbyes" in the main office hallway. This helps students transition to their day of learning, and allows staff to attend to students. If you need to speak with your child's teacher, we ask that you please make an appointment to confer outside student contact hours.

#### REGISTRATION

- · Please use the school team coupon code provided by your team captain to receive the lower school team pricing.
- · The coupon code is for your school team participants only and should not be shared with anyone who is not running with your school team.
- You can participate in any race (8K, 5K, or Fun Run OR Volunteer) to earn points for your team.
- · Parents, family members, and friends can all sign up to be part of the team as well.
- · Remember to select your school from the drop down team menu on the registration site.
- . If you would like to volunteer instead of run for your team: you also need to register through the website in order to earn points for your team. At the payment screen: type in VOLUNTEER in the coupon code spot.
- Registration deadline to count toward Awards & School team shirts is April 30th.

#### **SCHOOL TEAM SHIRTS**

- Once a team has 20 people signed up to run, you have earned your school team shirts (Run! Ballantyne tech shirt in your school team color with your school name on the sleeve.)
- School team members must register by the April 30<sup>th</sup> deadline in order to receive the School Team Shirts.
- Volunteers will receive a YMCA volunteer shirt vs. the school team tech shirt runners will receive.
- · You can still register to participate with your team up until May 7th. However, you will receive the regular race shirt instead of the school team shirt. (School team shirts are ordered at 8am on May 1st per vendor deadline. exceptions can be made.)

#### PACKET PICK UP

- School team packets will be delivered to the school c/o the team captain on Thursday, May 12th.
- · Team Captains will determine a plan to assemble and distribute the packets out to the team members.
- · Your team captain will communicate when/how you will receive your individual packet (containing your race shirt, bib/chip, Runner's Guide, goodies etc.)
