MOVEMENT FOR KIDS

NEW this year! Bartlett's Sensory Path. What is a sensory path? A sensory path is a series of guided movements for kids to follow, shown by markings on the floor and walls. As students follow the path and complete the movements, they work off excess energy and develop their gross motor skills.
