

The Helen M. Mulloy College Scholarship

Benefactor Mrs. Helen M. Mulloy: March 8, 1930 – March 3, 2008

The late Helen Mulloy, a longtime Flathead Valley resident did not have the opportunity to complete her high school education or attend college. She worked very hard in a large insurance company moving up the ladder from bookkeeper to the vice president of the company, while raising two daughters with her late husband John. Her legacy is to give local students the opportunity she never had to attend college. Mrs. Mulloy stated, "If kids have decent grades but not the money, I want to help them get through college. It is very important for people to have a start in education."

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. A graduating senior from Flathead or Glacier High Schools in Kalispell, Montana.
2. A 3.5 accumulated grade point average or above
3. Significant financial need
4. Attend an accredited four-year college/university
5. The fully completed scholarship must be submitted in the order listed below as specified

1. COVER SHEET – Type written

Cover sheet must include:

1. Scholarship and date submitted
2. Applicant's name
3. Applicants address and phone number
4. Applicants GPA both current and cumulative
5. List the colleges to which you have been accepted (list in order of priority)
6. State Career Goals in 50 words or less

2. VERIFICATION OF HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC RECORD

1. Attach official high school transcript through the seventh semester.

3. VERIFICATION OF FINANCIAL NEED

Please attach your information pertaining to this category in the following format:

1. Attach Student Aid Index generated from filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
2. Give any additional information pertaining to financial condition and/or need, typewritten statement must be 350 words or less.

4. VERIFICATION OF COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE

1. Attach a copy of the college acceptance letter from the college you plan to attend

5. VERIFICATION OF COLLEGE COMMITMENT – STUDENT PERSONAL STATEMENT

1. Describe why a college degree is important to you. Typewritten statement must be 350 words or less.

6. VERIFICATION OF COLLEGE POTENTIAL – TEACHER LETTER OF REFERENCE

1. Attach one letter of reference from a high school teacher which addresses the following:
 - A. Overview of the teacher's high school experience with applicant
 - B. The likelihood of applicant successfully completing a Baccalaureate Degree

1. All applications become the property of the Helen M. Mulloy College Scholarship Committee.
2. Applications must be submitted with all parts of scholarship in the order as listed above
