Medical Form

A medical form is enclosed. Please fill it out completely and return it with your payment. Please include any information you think would be necessary/helpful for the director/chaperone to know. ***Students will not be permitted to go on the trip without a completed medical form.*** Please note this form will be shared with your child's chaperone, the nurses attending the trip, and a copy of the form will be left in the First Aid Station at Hershey Park. There will be regular visits by the chaperones to check the First Aid Station.

Food

Students should bring breakfast and a lunch. They should eat breakfast on the way to the performance site and eat their lunch when they are done performing, or in between performances if their groups are spread out.

Money

The only money students will need for the day is for souvenirs and any additional food they would like. They will be given a meal voucher for dinner.

T-Shirts

Hershey t-shirts will be distributed at rehearsals the week of the trip. **Shirts may not be altered in any way and must be worn all day.** Students should report in their Hershey t-shirt, black pants, and sneakers. They will be able to change into park clothes when they are done performing. Blue "The Point Is Music" hoodies may be worn when they are not performing.

Chaperone instructions for the trip:

1. Chaperones will understand their specific duties and responsibilities for the trip.
2. Chaperones will have a roster of names and emergency phone numbers of all students they will be responsible for.
3. Chaperones will understand the specific number of students they are responsible for, safety regulations, emergency procedures to be used and expected student behavior.
4. Attendance will be taken each time students return to the bus.
5. The student/adult ratio will be one (1) chaperone to every twelve (12) students.
6. A Maple Point MS Administrator will accompany us on the trip.
7. Medical personnel will accompany us on the trip.

Student instructions for the trip:

1. This is a school activity and all school rules apply, **including the dress code.**
2. **Students must ride the bus to and from the festival.**
3. Appropriate behavior and courtesy should be practiced at all times.
4. Students should dress appropriately for weather.
5. Students must report and perform in uniform:
Hershey t-shirts (tucked in for performance) and BLACK pants. Sneakers may be worn. NO leggings or Yoga pants may be worn. Students may wear blue "The Point Is Music" hoodie when they are not performing.
6. Students will stay in groups at all times. If there is an indication that a student might wander, that student will be assigned one on one to a chaperone for the entire time.
7. Glass containers are not permitted on the bus.
8. All trash will be deposited in the bags provided.
9. Students may not change their groups or bus assignments.
10. Students that do not follow the above rules may lose the privilege of participating in further field trips.
11. Students will need to pack breakfast and lunch. Dinner in the park will be provided.
12. **Electronic devices are the responsibility of the student.** They must be powered down and not out during performances.
