

REQUIRED ACADEMIC COURSES:

Every student will be required to take four core academic courses. The courses are United States History, Science 8, English Language Arts 8, and Math. Current Math 7 students will be enrolled in Pre-Algebra.

ADVANCED LANGUAGE ARTS/ACCELERATED MATH COURSES:

- Advanced Language Arts 8 class placement will be determined in 7th grade through a self-selection process based upon recommended criteria. Information about the criteria and process can be found by scanning the QR code to the right.
- Students currently enrolled in Accelerated Math 7 will automatically be enrolled in Algebra 1.
- Students currently enrolled in Algebra 1 will automatically be enrolled in Geometry.
- Students taking Algebra 1 or Geometry are taking a high school course. The grade they receive will go on their transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into their high school grade point average (GPA).
- The Curriculum Department will send an email detailing the recommended criteria and process for students wanting to move from Math 7 to Algebra 1. This email is scheduled to go out on Feb. 9, 2024.

WORLD LANGUAGE ELECTIVE – Level 1 or Level 2: (THIS IS A HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL COURSE & NOT REQUIRED IN MIDDLE SCHOOL)

Students have the opportunity to begin learning a Level 1 World Language in 7th grade - PLEASE NOTE;

- World Language is <u>NOT</u> a required elective in middle school.
- Students receive a high school credit for passing this course, therefore, the workload, pacing and expectations reflect the norms of a high school level language course.
- The grade students earn in this course <u>will</u> be on the high school transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into the high school grade point average (GPA).
- Students who successfully complete a Level 1 language course in 7th grade can take the level 2 course of the same language in 8th grade.
- It is always recommended that students take consecutive World Language levels in consecutive years.
- For college bound students, it is recommended that students take at least one or two levels of World Language while at the high school.

ELECTIVE COURSES: Students will take 2 full-year electives <u>OR 1 full-year elective</u> and 2 semester electives, OR 4 semester electives.

- If your choice is 2 full-year electives, please choose either Band, Choir or Orchestra by marking an "X" <u>AND</u> choose your Level 2 World Language <u>or</u> rank order your preference for Level 1 World Language. Also rank order your preferences for the 20 week elective courses from 1-7.
- If your choice is 1 full year elective and 2 semester electives, please choose either Band, Choir or Orchestra by marking an "X" <u>OR</u> choose your Level 2 World Language <u>or</u> rank order your preference for Level 1 World Language. Also rank order your preferences for the 20 week elective courses from 1-7. *Every effort will be made to give students their top choices.*
- Band 8 or Orchestra 8 should only be marked if your student took Band 7 or Orchestra 7 in 7th grade or if special arrangements have been made through the Instrumental Music teacher.
- If your choice is 4 semester electives, please rank the order of preferences for the 20 week elective courses from 1-7 (#1 being your top choice). Every effort will be made to give students their top choices.

- 3. Sign the bottom of the Schedule Card.

STUDENTS – Please be sure to:

- 1. Sign the bottom of the Schedule Card.
- 2. Enter Elective courses and alternates in StudentVUE (Course Request)
- 3. Double check that your selections in StudentVUE match the selections on your paper schedule card THEN turn in the Schedule Card to your Social Studies class by MARCH 7, 2024.
