Eligibility for McKinney-Vento Services

IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES...

- » in a shelter
- » in a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation
- » in a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station
- » doubled-up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship your child might be able to receive help through a federal law called the McKinney-Vento Act.

YOUR MCKINNEY-VENTO ELIGIBLE CHILDREN HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- receive a free, appropriate public education.
- enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.
- enroll in the local school; or continue attending the school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
- If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
