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Course Description: This course is designed to provide students with the agency, tools, and knowledge necessary to live in and contribute to a financially sound society. The Economics and Personal Finance (EPF) course is intended to be a study of economics, personal finance, income and education, money management, critical consumerism, and financial planning.

Students in Economics and Personal Finance will take a final exam during the last five days of the semester. The Final Exam will count for 20% of your Final Grade.

Final Exam Exemption: Students with an A average do not have a limit on **EXCUSED** absences.

Students with a B average have a limit of two **EXCUSED** absences.

If a student has ANY **UNEXCUSED** absences(this applies to an A and a B), they will not be exempted from their exam

Bathroom Policy: The school will be using the Ehallpass system this year. Late work penalties are as follows:
