We live in a world surrounded by technology and we know that whatever field our children choose to go into as adults, their ability to succeed will increasingly hinge on understanding how technology works. But only a tiny fraction of students are learning computer science, and fewer are studying it than a decade ago.

During *Computer Science Education Week* (Dec. 9-15), our students will have the opportunity to join over 2 million people worldwide spending one hour learning the basics of computer programming.
