The pH Scale



INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING FOUR COMPONENTS: (25 points each)

1. Video component #1 or slide #1

Introduce yourself! Include your full name, class period and date. Explain what the pH scale tells us. (25 pts.)

2. Video component #2 or slide #2

a. Gather about 10–14 items within your household to classify as acids or bases. If you do not know if an item is an acid or a base...Google the info!

b. Arrange the items in a single group photo. (25 pts.)

3. Video component #3 or slide #3

Separate your household items into three groups:

group A = acids group B = bases group c = neutral

b. Record the items as classified groups for your video. Discuss three properties of acids and three properties of bases. You can even do a voice over! (25 pts.)

4. Video component #4

- a. Research the pH values to label the items with their correct pH. You should not repeat pH values. Only one item per value is needed.
- b. Arrange these items according to their pH values, from a pH of 0-14, lowest pH to highest pH. <u>Keep all products inside their</u> <u>containers</u>. (25 pts.)
