HOW TO CREATE A ONE-PAGER

One-pagers invite students to think deeply about a text and produce a single page of sketchnotes to represent its most important aspects.

Your one-pager should include the following details:

- Include a one paragraph well-written summary of the novel.
- Include a sketch and a sentence representing the setting.
- Include a statement about one thing you connected with in the reading.
- Draw a key symbol from the reading then write a sentence in your own words explaining the importance of the symbol.
- Create a border around your paper using three important quotations that show themes from the reading.
- Include five words or pictures across the paper that express the author's style.
- Pick your favorite character and list five words that describe them.
- Consider connections between the story and our modern day world. Express them in words and/or pictures.
- Somewhere on your paper, write a one-sentence review.
