Skills students need to complete this assignment:

- BW homework day

Steps:


1. Import a Portrait and textures into Pixlr
 - a. File > Open Image




2. Drag your portrait onto the canvas




3. Size your portrait to the canvas (Edit > Free Transform)




4. Desaturate the colors of your portrait to about 45 (Adjustment > Hue/Saturation) *Note - make sure you are selecting the right layer)




5. White out the eyes using a soft paint brush tool
 - a. Select paint brush tool
 - b. Soften brush
 - c. Lower opacity and paint white onto eyes




6. Darken around the eyes, the mouth and face edges of your portrait using the **burn** tool.




7. Pull on the meat layer onto the canvas, center it over your portrait




8. Change the layer blending mode to "multiply".



9. Erase most of the meat layer, leaving parts on the cheeks and corners of the mouth to look like open flesh.



10. Pull rock layer onto canvas and center over portrait (Edit > Free Transform). Change the layer blending mode to Overlay. Change the layer opacity to about 20.



11. Save your image
