

# How to Start a Project in Adobe Premiere

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**Purpose:** This is how you will start every new project in Adobe Premiere for your Film Assignments.

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## Starting a New Project

To begin, open up Adobe Premiere.

- Click on **New Project...**
- Under **Name:**, rename it to be what the Project is called. Do not leave it as *Untitled*.
- Under **Location:**, go to the right and click on the button **Browse...**
  - From here, you should have already made a *Project Folder* on your desktop. So in the Finder window, select *Desktop* on the right side under Favorites, then open your Project Folder and then select **Choose**.

These General settings should be set at the follow:

- **Video:** *Timecode*
- **Audio:** *Audio Samples*
- **Capture Format:** *DV*

When all of the following is correct, press **OK**.

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## Creating a New Sequence


There are different ways to create a sequence in your Project.

1. In your **Project Folder**(The bottom left box next to the *Sequence Timeline*), right click on the empty space, then **New Item > Sequence**.
2. Go to **File** at the top on the **Menu Bar**, then **New > Sequence**.

Once you've done that, a **New Sequence** window will open up. From there, make sure to do the following:

Select under the **Available Presets:**

**ARRI > 1080p > ARRI 1080p 30**



Next, go to the bottom and under **Sequence Name:**, rename this to your *Project Name*. Do not leave as *Sequence 01*, etc.

When finished, click **OK**.
