Photographing and uploading artwork (using your Chromebook)

Follow the step by step directions on the slides that follow!

First....find the **launcher** at the bottom right corner of your chromebook screen. You can also use the **magnifying glass** for this step. CLICK ON IT or PRESS IT. Click on arrow and it will open apps. Click on Camera icon.





Click the CAMERA icon



Look for the green light at the top of your chromebook screen to appear

Your camera is now on!



Make sure you are in a well-lit area!

Hold up your artwork in front of the camera so that ALL of it shows

*Not TOO close, not TOO far away



You can brighten your computer screen so that the picture is brighter and clearer.



Look for the list of modes on the right

Click PHOTO



Click the grey circle to take the photo

*You may want to have someone help you with this so you can hold the artwork up correctly

*You can take many photos until you get it right - they all save automatically!

Click the circle under the word Square.



You can select the CROP tool from the bottom bar of edit options if you want to send me a close up of your art.



TO CROP:

Click and drag the sides and corners to focus ONLY on the artwork

The crop tool will cut out parts you don't want.

If you don't edit/crop the picture it doesn't save the changes, including the new name.
