

High School Diploma with Associates of Science Pathway

This is a list of suggested courses for students to follow each year if they are interested in graduating high school with an Associates of Science from Edison State Community College. Attached to this page you will see the requirements as listed by Edison for the degree. The pathway listed below is intended for students to stay at FM to take the required courses. They will need to take 2-3 courses either online or at Edison (Humanities, a course for their diversity requirement, and possibly a math course depending on the student's current math track). This information is based on the classes that are currently being offered at FM. If any changes happen and the CCP classes change or are no longer offered, the counselor will work with students to find an appropriate alternative.
