Ogilvie Secondary is seeking applicants for a High School EBD/ABS Teacher starting for the 2024-2025 school year.

Description: Experience working with middle and/or high school age EBD students; knowledge and experience writing IEP's, knowledge of MN EBD/ABS criteria and the evaluation process including Functional Behavior Assessments; knowledge of due process procedures; ability to work with a team; training or willingness to be trained in Crisis Prevention Intervention (CPI); and excellent oral and written communication skills
