3. Ability to establish positive working relationships with students, staff, and parents through an equitable and trauma informed lens.
4. Willingness to work with extra-curricular activities.

1. Master's degree.
2. Spanish language skills.

SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Implement adopted curriculum and develop supplemental instructional materials that are aligned to grade level standards and suitable for students with a wide range of mental, physical, and emotional maturities.
2. Use data to inform instruction, evaluate academic growth, and monitor student progress on grade level standards.
3. Maintain appropriate records.
4. Actively engage in curriculum and/or faculty committees as interested or required.
5. Work collaboratively with other staff members to support student learning.
6. Establish and maintain open lines of communication with students & their parents concerning academic and behavioral progress of student.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: 190-Day Contract at 1.0 FTE. Based on current SEA salary schedule and negotiated agreement, salary dependent on the negotiated agreement (\$50,073-\$101,649 annually) with excellent benefits including Medical, Dental and Vision insurance and Oregon state retirement.
