- A **Lexile** score is a measurement of student reading achievement and/or difficulty level of a text. Student Lexile scores are provided after taking the *Reading Inventory* assessment.
- Lexile scores are provided after students take the *Reading Inventory* assessment, which is administered three times/year (fall, mid-year & end of year).
- A reader's Lexile score can then be matched with similar Lexile texts so the reader experiences confidence and control over the reading process. Lexiles range from Beginning Reader to above 1500L.
- After analyzing the past 3 years, since implementing *Read 180*, this year's 10th grade students averaged an 11 point gain on their Reading MCA score—from 8th grade to 10th grade MCA.
