7th Grade:

Family & Consumer Science: 1 box of straight pins & container and one 12-quart plastic storage tub with lid (bring 2 nd semester)
Reading: Loose- paper, writing utensils. 1” binder
Science: 1” binder just for science, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers
English: a 1" binder, writing utensils, and a notebook (composition or spiral)
Social Studies: 1” binder just for social studies
Math: notebook, a 1” binder, scientific calculator, book cover
Computer: set of ear buds or headphones for listening to lessons
JH Choir: black folder, pencils
JH General Music: folder, 1 notebook, pencils

8th Grade:

Reading: a 1" binder and writing utensils
Science: 1” binder just for science, loose-leaf paper
English: a 1" binder, writing utensils, and a notebook (composition or spiral)
Math: notebook, a 1” binder, scientific calculator, graph paper, book cover
History: 1” binder just for history, loose-leaf paper
Computer: set of ear buds or headphones for listening to lessons
Family & Consumer Science: 1 box of straight pins & container and one 12-quart plastic storage tub with lid
JH Choir: black folder, pencils
JH General Music: folder, 1 notebook, pencils
Agriculture: 1” binder
Algebra: scientific calculator other than your phone, 1” binder

9th Grade -12th Grade

Accounting: an external 10-key keypad **highly recommended
Geometry: scientific calculator other than your phone, 1” binder, compass, protractor
Algebra I: notebook, a 1” binder, scientific calculator, graph paper, book cover
Algebra II and higher: graphing calculator recommended (TI-83/TI 84), 1½ “ binder and paper
U.S. History: notebook and folder
AP US History: 3-ring binder
Agriculture Classes: 3-ring binder and notebook
Clothing: straight pins & container, 1-yard of cotton woven fabric with a printed side, old pair of jeans or scrap denim pieces. Students will select projects within categories on a contract and then will purchase the pattern, fabric, and supplies needed for at least 2 projects. Theses items will need to be purchased by the 4 th week of the course.
9-11 English: 1 3-ring binder, 3 pocket dividers, 1 pack index cards and Post-it notes, loose-leaf paper, blue or black pens (No binder or dividers needed for English 9)
Health: notebook to use for a journal
Foundations of Writing: college ruled notebook, lined index cards, pocket folder, 1½-2” three-ring binder, loose-leaf paper
Spanish I-IV: Notebook, folder
Conceptual Chemistry: 1 ½ “binder just for chemistry, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers, scientific calculator
Biology: 3-ring binder
Foundations of Math: scientific calculator other than your phone, 1”binder
Physics: 1 ½ “binder just for physics, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers, scientific calculator
Chemistry II: 1 ½ “binder just for chemistry, ear buds, 4 pk of white board markers, scientific calculator
Comp I & II: 3-ring binder
Pre-Employment Strategies: binder and clear sheet protectors
Foods 1 -ingredients for chosen pie final and a pie plate or tin-not needed until end of semester
Foods 2 -ingredients to make 10 “At-Home” recipes they will be required to cook for their family (7 assigned categories & 3 choice recipes); If a family/student has issues with this assignment they will need to contact the teacher within the first 2 weeks of the course and arrange time before or after school to prepare recipes.
Foods 3 -Weekly on-site bakery labs require closed toe shoes.
