Your Task

In a cohesive paper or presentation, you will:

- Analyze a current or historical environmental issue by providing background information that analyzes the development of the issue.
 State a claim about an environmental issue.
- □ Provide reasons for your claim, supported by evidence, including:
 - o A possible solution or an alternative solution (historical).
 - An analysis of benefits and/or costs of two or more stakeholders' uses of the environment.
- ☐ Cite specific textual evidence from at least three credible sources that provide relevant information.
