What is I-ready?

i-Ready is an interactive online learning environment designed to assess students and provide individualized instruction based on each one's unique needs. The exciting format and engaging content, as well as the Study Buddies and other interesting contemporary characters draw students in right away.

- i-Ready builds students' investment in their learning by giving them real-time feedback on their progress in each skill
- As students complete each assignments, they earn credits that they can use to play games.

## How does my child log on to I-ready?

I-ready must be accessed through Clever. Students will use their MSIS number to log on to Clever and they will see the I-Ready logo. Once they click the logo, it will connect them to the I-Ready program and they will be prompted to choose Math or Reading.

How can I help my child get the most out of I-ready?

- Talk with your child about how using i-Ready at home will help him/her prepare for class work.
- Explain that i-Ready will show teachers where your child is doing well, and which topics need some more review.
- Encourage your child to use the tools provided during lessons and to use scrap paper to work out math problems.
- Help your child identify and become familiar with the different parts of the student home page ("My Assignments", "My Stuff", "My Progress").
- Parents can also support their child by making sure students are getting 45 minutes of online instruction per subject each week.
- Encourage your child to take each lesson and question seriously.
- Emphasize "thinking before clicking", because just clicking through will not give teachers an accurate report of what your child knows and is able to do.
- Discuss your child's results by looking at the "My Progress" box with him/her.
- Contact your child's teacher about how often your child should practice at home, or with any other questions about i-Ready


View your child's "My Progress" box.

How can I help my child with the diagnostic assessment at home?

I-Ready is designed to complement what is being taught in the classroom. The lessons are assigned based on how your child performed in the Diagnostic test, which he/she must complete before starting work on the lessons. The lessons are presented in three parts: tutorial, guided practice, and graded activity. Your child will get relevant instruction with supportive feedback as he/she progresses through the lessons.
