

## Southside High School IB/Magnet Status Rubric

<b>Senior (Grade 12)</b>	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> required IB Diploma courses, including TOK, Extended Essay and CAS. To earn the Diploma, student receives at least 24 cumulative points on HL/SL assessments; no less than 12 points on HL assessments and 9 points on SL assessments. Diploma scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment, with pre-approval from principal.	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>some</u> IB courses <u>excluding</u> TOK, Extended Essay and CAS. Student scheduling conflicts may result in the student making course selections that ensure course status. Student is not eligible for independent study or virtual course enrollment if the course is not needed for graduation.	Student is <u>NOT</u> enrolled/scheduled to complete IB courses. Student is not eligible for independent study or virtual course enrollment. Student may apply for special permission to attend to Southside.	Student is eligible for all Honors/AP courses. Scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment with pre-approval from principal.
<b>Junior (Grade 11)</b>	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> IB Diploma required courses/programs including TOK. The student begins work on Extended Essay and CAS. Diploma scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment, with pre-approval from principal.	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>some</u> IB courses, <u>excluding</u> TOK. Student scheduling conflicts may result in the student making course selections that ensure course status. Student is not eligible for independent study or virtual course enrollment if the course is not needed for graduation.	Student is <u>NOT</u> enrolled/scheduled to complete IB courses. Student is not eligible for independent study or virtual course enrollment Student's magnet status is rescinded and the student must return to his home-based school.	Student is eligible for all Honors/AP courses. Scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment with pre-approval from principal.
<b>Sophomore (Grade 10)</b>	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> required Honors and AP courses. Student should complete all Fine Arts and graduation elective credits prior to eleventh grade. Magnet scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment with pre-approval from principal.	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> required Honors and AP courses. Student should complete all Fine Arts and graduation elective credits prior to eleventh grade. Magnet scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment, with pre-approval from principal.	Student is <u>NOT</u> enrolled/scheduled to complete Honors or AP courses. Student is not eligible for independent study or Online enrollment Student's magnet status is rescinded and the student must return to his home-based school.	Student is eligible for all Honors/AP courses. Scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment with pre-approval from principal.
<b>Freshman (Grade 9)</b>	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> required Honors and AP courses as part of the IB Diploma Program. Incoming high school principal's pre-approval is needed for virtual course enrollment. Student may not be eligible for independent study.	Student is enrolled/scheduled to complete <u>all</u> required Honors and AP courses. Incoming high school students must have principal's pre-approval before enrolling in a virtual course. Student may not be eligible for independent study.	Student does not meet Magnet status. Student is not eligible for enrollment at Southside.	Student is eligible for all Honors/AP courses. Scheduling conflicts may result in independent study or virtual course enrollment with pre-approval from principal.
<b>Note:</b> Magnet/IB students who plan to attend the Fine Arts or a Career Center during their high school career must make intentions known in advance of the start of 9 <sup>th</sup> grade. Scheduling conflicts may result in difficult choices.
