REMEDIATION RECOVERY PROGRAM REGULATION

The Brunswick County Public Schools System provides a remediation recovery program in accordance with policy IKG.

Students in grades 3 through 10 who pass their English and/or Mathematics course but fail the associated SOL test are required to attend summer school for remediation. Inclusive in this is the General Assembly-required remediation of third graders who fail the reading SOL test before being promoted to the fourth grade. Additionally, Project Graduation participation is encouraged for students in grades 11 and 12 who pass their English and/or Mathematics class and fail the associated SOL test. Project Graduation remediation services are also available during the school year.

During the school year, all three elementary schools and the middle school have a remediation period built into the regularly scheduled day. This provides additional support to students who fail their English and/or Mathematics SOL test and will count on both the previous and present grade levels if they pass their SOL test during the current year. Also, in the middle school any student who fails the grade 5-7 mathematics SOL test is scheduled into a year-long Algebra Readiness class during the school day. This is inclusive of the General Assembly mandate that students win grades six through eight who demonstrate deficiencies on the SOL mathematics assessment be provided with targeted mathematics remediation and intervention.
