If the first dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. Additionally, if a pupil is in the 12th grade and is 15 years of age or younger, only one (1) dose is required. Therefore, your current 11th grader will need to show proof of having received the required meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine(s) before they can return to school in August. You are receiving this letter now in order to provide ample time to have your child immunized before the coming school year begins.
