STATISTICS ABOUT ART IN SCHOOL

Students who study art in school

- 3 times more likely to be acknowledged for school attendance
- 4 times more likely to be recognized for academic achievement.
- Scored 100 points higher on their SATs than students who were not involved in the arts



STATISTICS ABOUT ART IN SCHOOL





- The 3 countries that rank highest in math and science include Japan, Hungary and the Netherlands. All 3 countries REQUIRE students to study art every year in school.
- Students with low to no participation in arts have a dropout rate of 22%. Students with high participation in the arts have a dropout rate of only 4%.

Low-income students with high art participation are more likely to....

- have gainful employment
- complete college and
- volunteer in communities

72% of business leaders say the #1 skill they look for when hiring is **creativity.**






"THERE'S NO JOBS IN THE ARTS."

- There are 3 million people working in over 600,000 art-centric businesses in the U.S.
- Creative industries estimate \$30 billion annually.
- More people are employed in the visual arts than in all of performing arts and sports industry combined.
- Jobs for photographers have increased
 38% within the last 4 years.







"THERE'S NO JOBS IN THE ARTS."

- Jobs for designers have increased
 43% within the last 10 years.
- People spend \$55 billion on video games every year- a product that is created by a team of *artists*.

- Web Developer- \$72-160,000
- Interior Designer-\$60,000

- Industrial Designer- \$60-100,000
- Photographers-\$60,090
- Film and Video Editors-\$66,715








AVERAGE SALARIES FOR ANIMATORS ACCORDING TO THEANIMATION GUILD






Storyboard Artists- \$2161/week



become!






Creative Skills-

You have to be creative to come up with an idea for your drawing! You have to decide where and how you will draw it, what colors you will choose, what the style will be, etc.

Critical Thinking Skills-

This is especially used when you are drawing anything from reference. You are analyzing the shapes and lines of an object and critically thinking up ways you can recreate that on your paper.




Problem Solving Skills-
