

Salma Hayek

You are married to Salma G Hayek. The two of you have decided to file your income taxes jointly. Your SSN is 555-77-5555; Salma's SSN is 777-55-5555. You have no children together yet. Neither of you are blind and neither of you were born before 1950. Feel free to invent a fictional Wisconsin address for your tax forms. The two of you are living together along with your mother: Melina (SSN 555-55-0007) and Salma's father: Antonio Hayek (SSN 555-55-0070). Because Salma and you support them, they are both considered your dependents. Melina shares your last name and is considered disabled

You worked at one full-time job all year. Income from this job was \$63,572.91. Salma has not been in any big films this past year. Her income that she received was from a small independent film for \$65,000.

You had income from a savings account in the amount of \$87.14 and nothing from dividends. Salma had income from a savings account in the amount of \$1193.56 and \$2500.00 from dividends.

A number of years back, you had a child together with a girlfriend that broke up with you and moved with the child to Iceland. You are required to pay her \$550 per month in alimony. Her SSN is 575-75-7575.

Deductions

■ Salma and you had medical and dental expenses last year from out-of-pocket and deductibles that totaled \$1495.82.

■ You paid state income taxes last year that totaled \$3058.92. Your property taxes from last year totaled \$3457.66.

■ Your home mortgage interest from last year totaled \$709.46.

■ Salma bought you a brand new vehicle last year, so the both of you decided to donate your 2011 Kia Sorento to St Peter's Catholic Church as a tax deductible donation on July 1, 2014. At the time of donation, it was appraised for a value of \$8500.00. You originally purchased that vehicle in December 2012. Form 8283 is attached with Section B, Part II and Part III already filled out by the appraiser and receiving organization.

■ You will have to calculate if these deductions, when itemized, will get you more of a tax break compared to the standard deduction. Take the better tax break. Include Schedule A with the tax forms that you hand in even if the standard deduction is the better deal.

This past year, you paid a provider called Heals on Wheels on 789 West Street \$325 per month to help take care of Melina and her disabilities.

The amount of federal income tax that was withheld on your individual W-2 was \$7998.68 and for Salma was \$8059.26.

Calculate the refund that the federal government owes you and sign the completed tax form.

Information you will need for your Wisconsin State Income Tax Form:

For line 11 Your employers have paid most of your health insurance costs, however, \$215 per month is taken out of your paycheck to pay for what your employer does not cover. Also, make sure you take the deduction for Dependent Care Expenses.

The amount of state income tax that was withheld on your W-2 was \$2639.17. The amount from Salma's job was \$2855.43.
