

Independent Study Expectations

Attendance Requirement: Students who are 16 and older must complete 10 hours of seat time per quarter credit. Students who are 15 will be required to complete 25 hours per quarter credit. **Courses will not be considered complete until students have completed the assigned PLATO course and met the seat time requirements.**

Note Requirement: Students are required to take notes throughout their assigned course. These notes are to be submitted to the Independent Study Coordinator once the student has completed the course.

Grading: Students will be graded on a combination of module completions, test scores, attendance and daily work as well as writing.

<i>Learning Module Completion (15%)</i>	This is just completing all the activities in the course.
<i>Mastery Tests (15%)</i>	Master tests do not count as 'complete' unless you get 80% on them. You can go through the tutorial again to unlock it if needed.
<i>Unit Post Tests (15%)</i>	Each unit will have a test at the end. You only get one try on these, but you can use your notes.
<i>End of Semester Tests (15%)</i>	This will be the very last thing in the course. It covers the whole course and, like post tests, you can use your notes.
<i>Attendance/Participation (10%)</i>	Complete your attendance hours and be on task!
<i>Writing (30%)</i>	A combination of discussion posts (if the course has any), unit activities and notes.* <i>*You are required to write a page of notes for each tutorial/lesson in your course (unless exempted).</i>
