


Al + Social Justice






Growth in Al Programs at Leading Universities

- Introduction of a specialized Al Track where students can specialize in the intersection of Al + any field of interest



MIT

- A \$350 million gift enabled the establishment of the MIT Stephen A.
 Schwarzman College of Computing in 2018 dedicated to Al education
- Created 50 new faculty positions related to AI, doubling MIT's academic capability in computing & AI



Carnegie Mellon University

- CMU launched the first undergraduate Al degree in the U.S. in 2018
