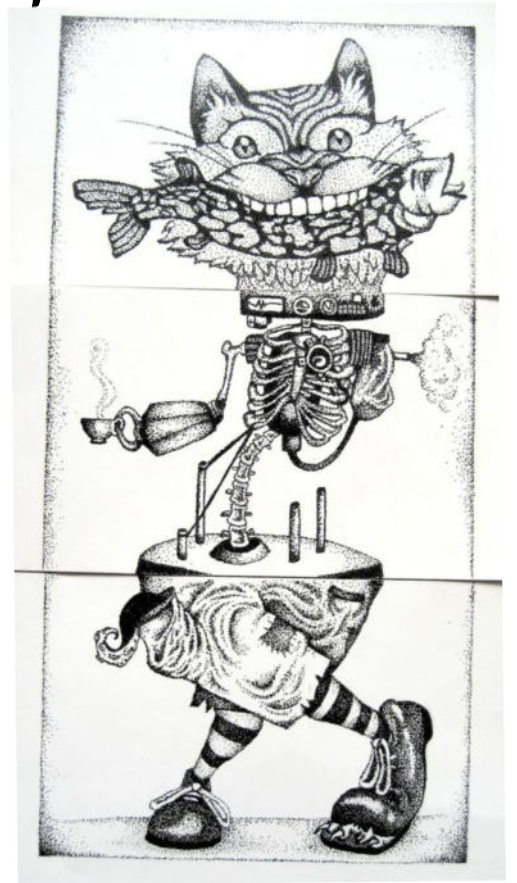


Exquisite Corpse

- Segments were done blindly, meaning that the previous person didn't know what they were adding onto.

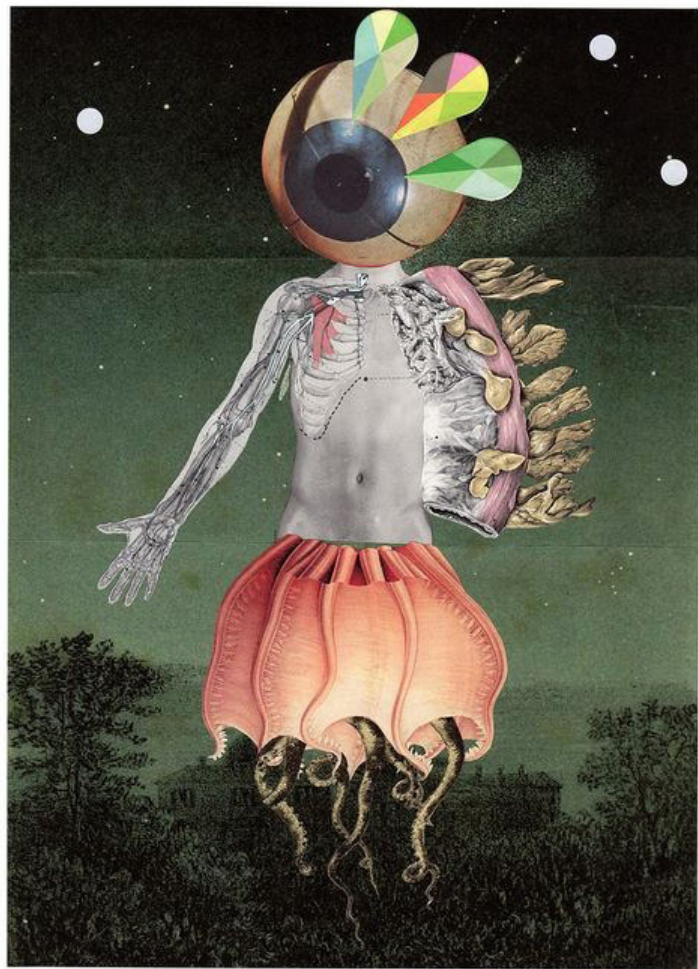
Modified...

Remember, the Exquisite Corpse was born out of the Surreal Movement, where the imagery was bizarre and very dream-like. Make sure your design embodies that essence.



Because you are doing this on your own, you have the freedom to make the “creature” look a little more unified than you would if you were trading this off to others. Take advantage of that fact and make adjustments as you work through your design each day.

You have the freedom to use any materials you want to (including digital art, if you have the ability to do so). Regardless of the material, though, I expect a well thought out design with excellent craftsmanship.

Preparing Your Area

- To get started you can work either on a **piece of watercolor paper** (it's nice because it's a little heftier) or **a page in your sketchbook** (no need to tear it out).
- You are going to want to make sure you use all of the page constructively
- Get out the materials that you think you'll use...best to have things on hand when you need them

YOUR FIRST PROMPT

The **HEAD**

The head can be of any creature, animal, human etc that you want...**BUT it must include a breathing apparatus** (something that would help it breath out of it's natural environment).

Remember, all work must be original. You can't use Sponge Bob's head for your creature. I am above all looking at craftsmanship and creativity.

YOUR SECOND PROMPT

The **TORSO**

For the second section of your Exquisite Corpse:

1. The creature needs to change (if you did a human for the head, you need to think of something different for the torso. Or if you did a bird head, you need to do something else besides a bird for the torso...however, it can be another animal).
2. This creature is in unfamiliar territory. Equip it with clothing and/or accessories that help it to survive in this foreign landscape it's in.

YOUR THIRD PROMPT

The **LEGS AND FEET**

For the third section of your Exquisite Corpse:

1. The creature needs to change (if you did a dog for the body, you need to think of something different for the torso...maybe a fantasy creature or a human.)
2. This creature is from another time period. Give it footwear from the past or present. You might need to do a little research to get some ideas of what people wore in the past as footwear OR make up something completely bizarre as an expression of future fashion.

YOUR FINAL PROMPT

The BACKGROUND

For the last component of your Exquisite Corpse:

1. You will need to fill the background of your illustration so that your creature isn't just floating in thin air.
2. Your background will be based on a Grimm Brother's Fairy Tale. Follow the Wikipedia link, find a fairy tale you'd like to base your background off of and illustrate that. There are TONS so if you want to try something new that you're not familiar with, try clicking on the name of one of the tales and read through the synopsis to get your creative juices flowing. I'd love to know what fairy tale you based your background off of if it's not obvious. :)
