



Regents Exams

- ► NYS Required Exams
- Annual, based on individual student schedules
- June 2021- courses ending in an exam
- ► August 2021- for students who fail or wish to receive a higher grade

GPA Calculation

- Calculation is based on all grades with the exception of physical education
- ► All Honors and Advanced Placement courses are weighted by a factor of 1.1
- ► GPAs are rounded to the hundredth (ex: 3.68)
- ► Accelerated courses are NOT weighted.
- ► GPA vs. weighted GPA

GPA CALCULATION WORKSHEET

Method to calculate GPA and Weighted GPA:

AP US HISTORY

Take the total GPA or Weighted GPA points and divide that number by the total credits earned.
