# INVASIVE SPECIES MOST WANTED

**Task:** Create a “Wanted” poster for an invasive species in Canada.

You must include in your poster:

- **NAME / ALSO KNOWN AS** (common name / "criminal" name)
- **PICTURE** – a drawing or photograph (colour would be nice)
- **CRIMES COMMITTED** by your species (crimes must be specific to your species and not general to all invasive species)
- **IDENTIFYING CHARACTERISTICS** – key features to look for when identifying the criminal
- **KNOWN ASSOCIATE(S)** – how did this species get to Canada?
- **LAST SEEN** – where did the species originally come from?
- **SUSPECTED HIDEOUTS** - where in Canada is it a problem?
- **REWARD** for elimination of your species (think about how the ecosystems would benefit from the elimination of your invasive species and explain your reasoning)
