

## IOWA STATE USBC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

In 2018 the Iowa State Women's Bowling Association established a \$1,000 per year scholarship to award deserving youth female and male bowlers for their accomplishments on the lanes, in their communities, and in the classroom. Scholarships are renewable for up to four years for a total of \$4,000 if qualifications are met.

Applicants must meet the following general qualifications:

- 1. Be a graduating senior from any Iowa State high school.
- Enrolled or plan to enroll and pursue a degree at a 2 or 4-year accredited college, university, or enroll in a vocational-technical school.
- 3. Be bowling in an Iowa State USBC certified league.
- Have a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 GPA scale high school grade point average at time of application.
- Renewed scholarship recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA college, university or vocational-technical school to receive future funds.

Applicants must submit the following by March 1:

- 1. This application completely filled out and signed by applicant.
- 2. Transcript OR most recent grade report.
- 3. Achievements and activities.
- 4. Counselor's letter of recommendation.
- One-page essay from the applicant on "What life lessons has bowling taught me and where do I see myself in 5 years" (type of computer-generate your essay of at least 150-200 words).
- Proof of enrollment in college, university or vocational-technical school.
- 7. Renewed scholarships must submit proof of college, university, or vocational-technical school grade point by June 1.
