Scholarship Overview

Award:

The Irene Ritter Foundation Scholarship is provided by the Irene Ritter Foundation, a family foundation based in New York City and established in the memory of Irene Ritter. These one-time awards are to support college-bound students as they further their education.

Amount of Award(s):

A total of three awards will be distributed. One \$5,000 award will be designated for a student enrolling in a four-year college or university. Two \$2,500 awards will be designated for two students enrolling in a two-year college. The awards will be presented to Long Branch High School graduating seniors who have been accepted to and are enrolled in institutions of higher education.

Eligibility Requirements: Eligible candidates are high school seniors who:

- 1. are seniors that attend Long Branch High School;
- 2. are in good academic standing, with a cumulative grade average of B or above;
- 3. are in good disciplinary standing during their four years of high school;
- 4. will be enrolled in college in 2019;
- 5. demonstrate financial need; and
- 6. have been active in community service.

Application Process:

Candidates who meet all the eligibility requirements must submit the completed scholarship application along with the following:

- a resume;
- two letters of recommendation (with at least one from a teacher) and reference information;
- proof of college acceptance; and
- the most recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
