
Dear Families,

BCIS Arrivals and Dismissals

Students being dropped off or walking to school should enter the building at the front door. All visitors to BCIS must enter the building via the door closest to the school office and report to Mrs. Sweigart, secretary. Mrs. Sweigart will have you sign in, and we ask that you wear your visitor badge at all times. Students should not arrive prior to 8:30 in the morning. Any student who leaves school before the designated dismissal time must have permission from the principal. Please keep the following in mind:

- Students arriving after 10:15 will be marked absent ½ day.
- Students signing out before 1:45 will be marked absent ½ day.
- Students signing out after 2:45 will be marked as early dismissal.

Bus Riders and Student Dismissal

All students who ride the bus to school must go home on the bus unless there is a note or phone call to the office. Please call the office prior to 2:30 if you are requesting changes to your child's dismissal. If you are running late to pick up your child, please let us know. We expect all students who ride the bus to follow all bus rules and remain seated while the bus is moving. We take our students' safety very serious.

A parent/guardian must come to the school office to sign the student out before the office releases the student to their parent/guardian during the school day. When school dismisses at the end of the day, we will release the students to their parents outside via car pick-up or walker pick-up. If the office does not receive a note prior to dismissal, the parent/guardian will need to go to the office to pick up his/her child. We will ask for a valid ID when you are picking up your child. This is for the protection and safety of all students.
