ISASP Short Reading

“The Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) includes individual assessments in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, and Science intended for use within the last 12 weeks of the academic year. These summative assessments measure student achievement, growth and college and career readiness based on the Iowa Core Standards.”

- ISASP Test Specification Guide, 2019

ISASP Short Reading

“Summative Assessment - Any method of evaluation that measures students’ cumulative learning against standard criteria over a set period, typically over the span of the course or school year. State summative test results are used in a variety of ways in different states and districts — as a comparable measure of student performance across schools, districts, and years; as part of state and local accountability systems to measure school performance; as a component of teacher evaluations, and in some cases as a graduation requirement or benchmark measure for students.”

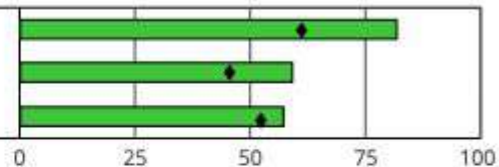

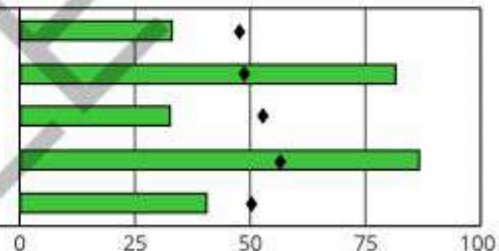

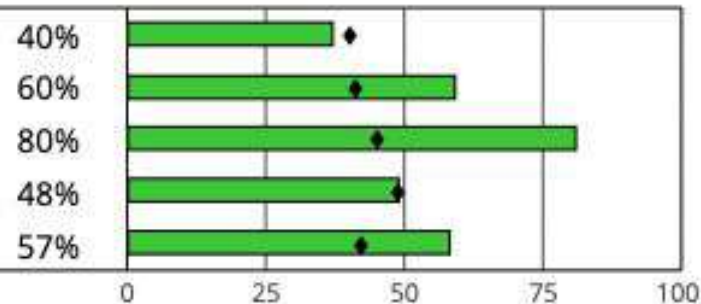

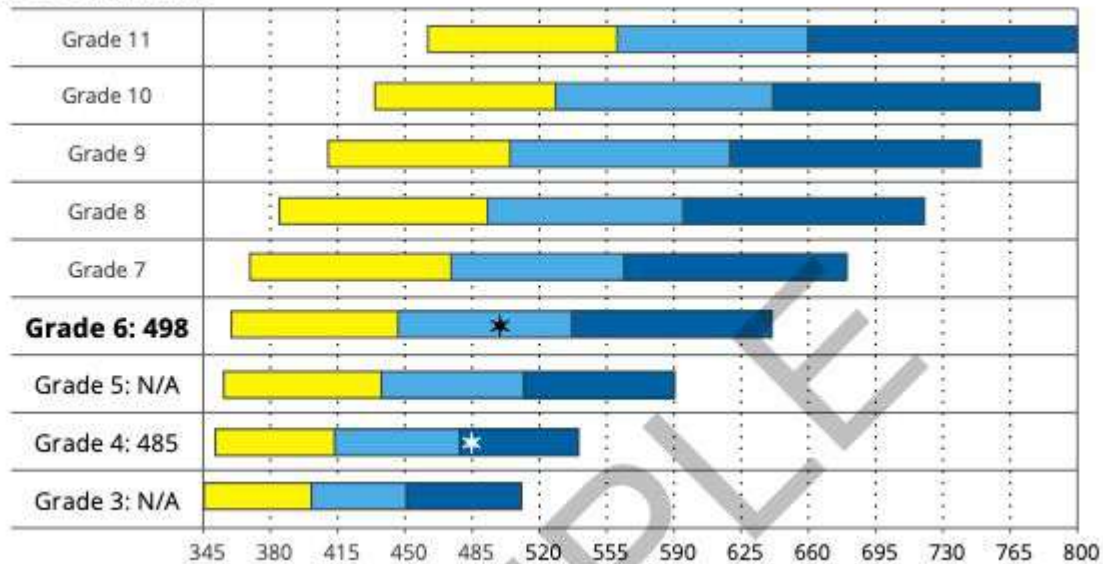

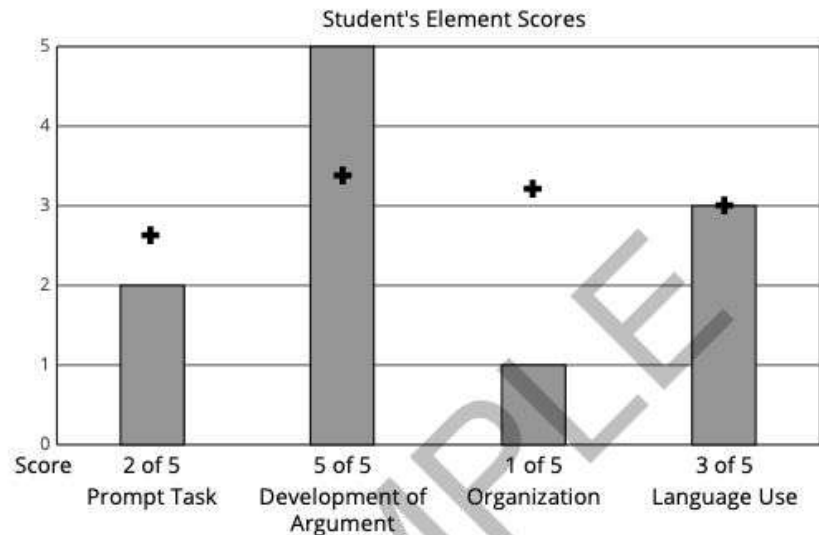

DEPTH OF KNOWLEDGE (DOK)

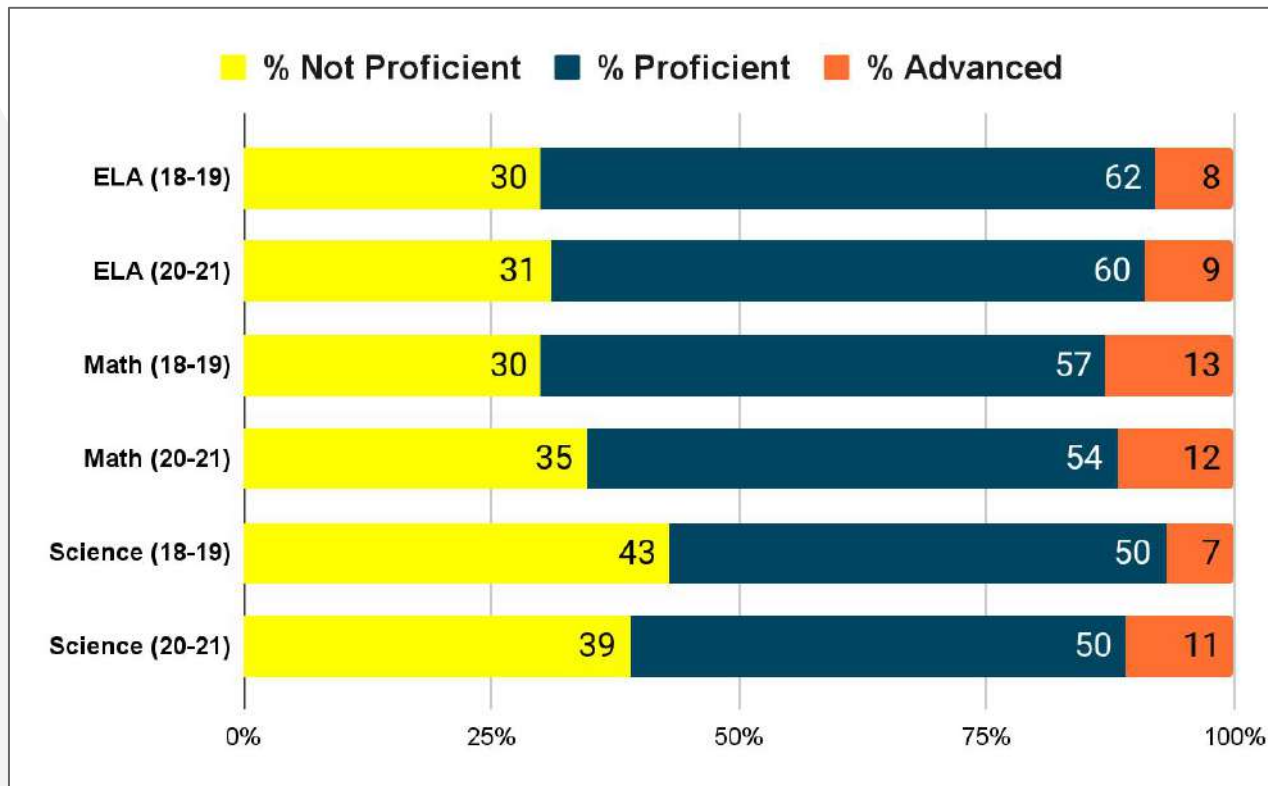
Each item on the ISASP is identified with a depth of knowledge (DOK) level. DOK, or cognitive complexity, reflects the type and level of thinking and reasoning required of students when interacting with a particular item. The table displays a fraction indicating the points your student earned out of the total points possible in that DOK level.

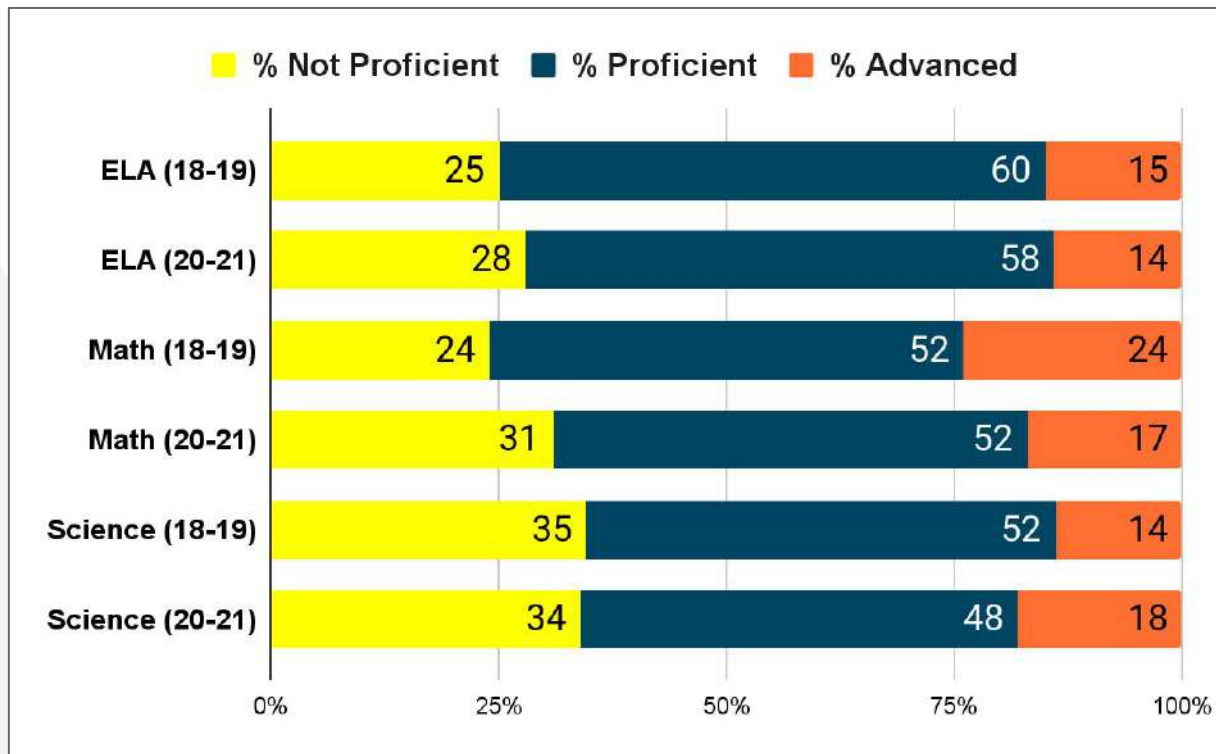

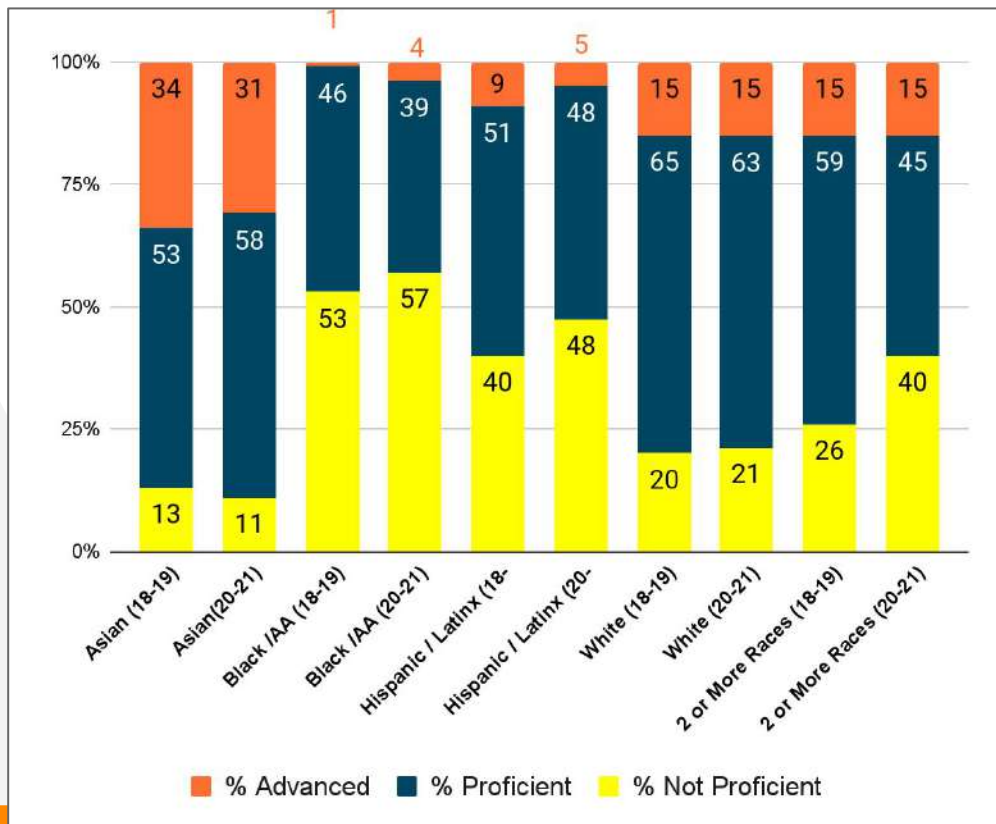

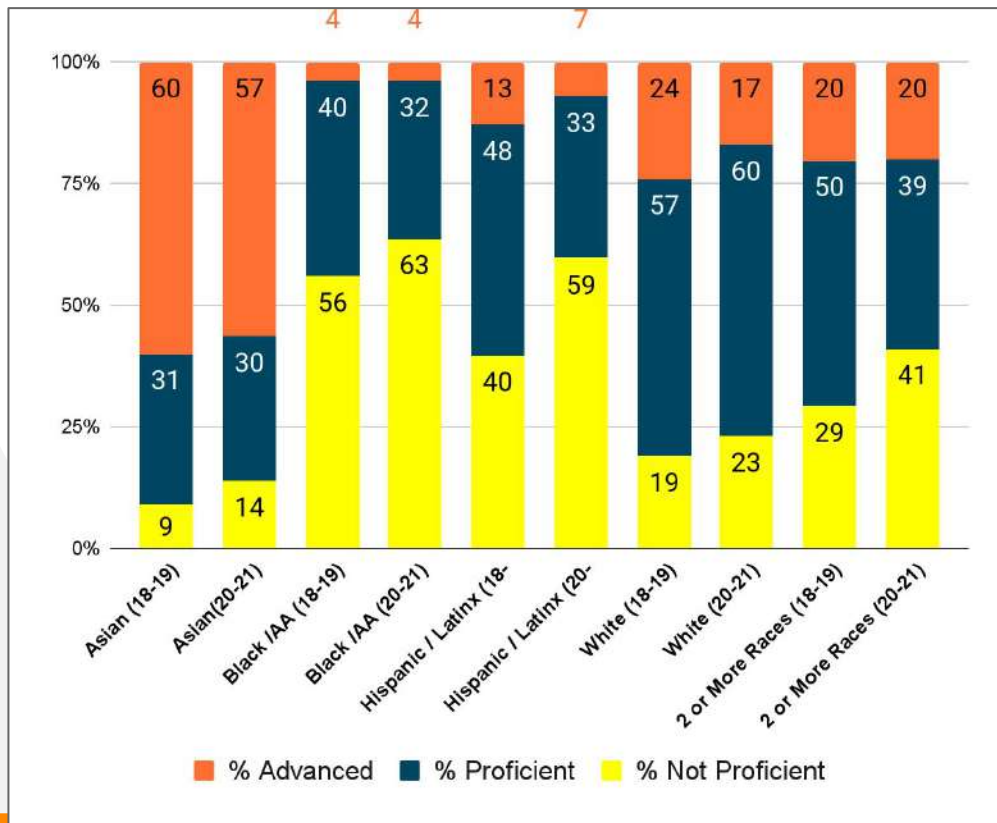
ACSD district-level ISASP results



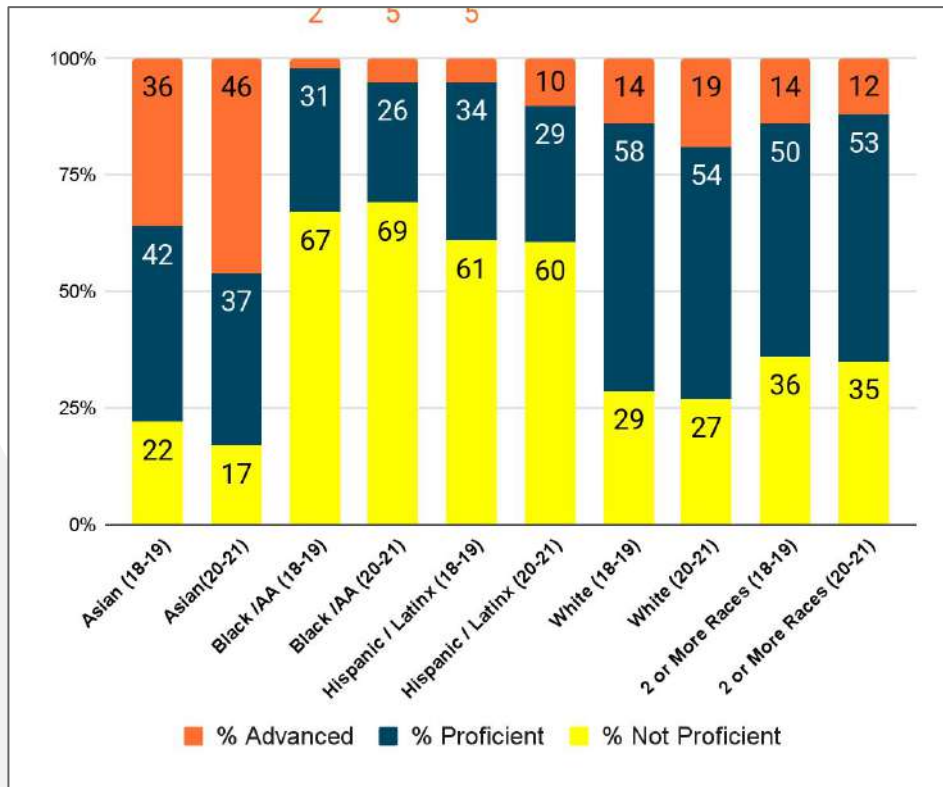

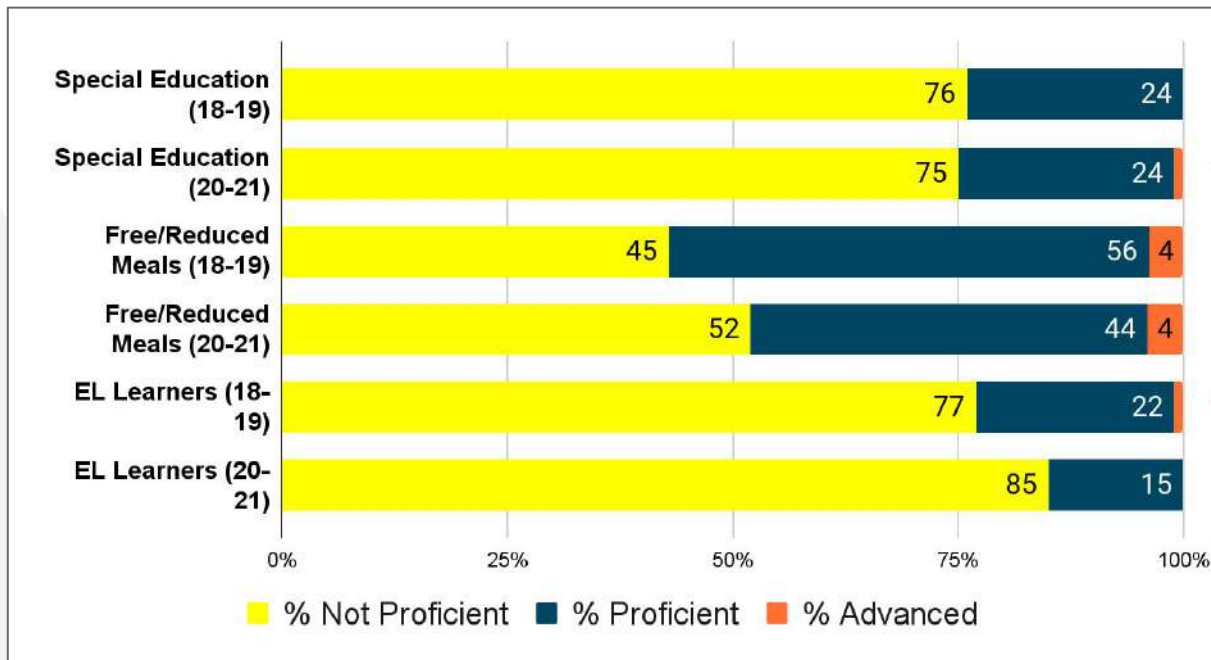

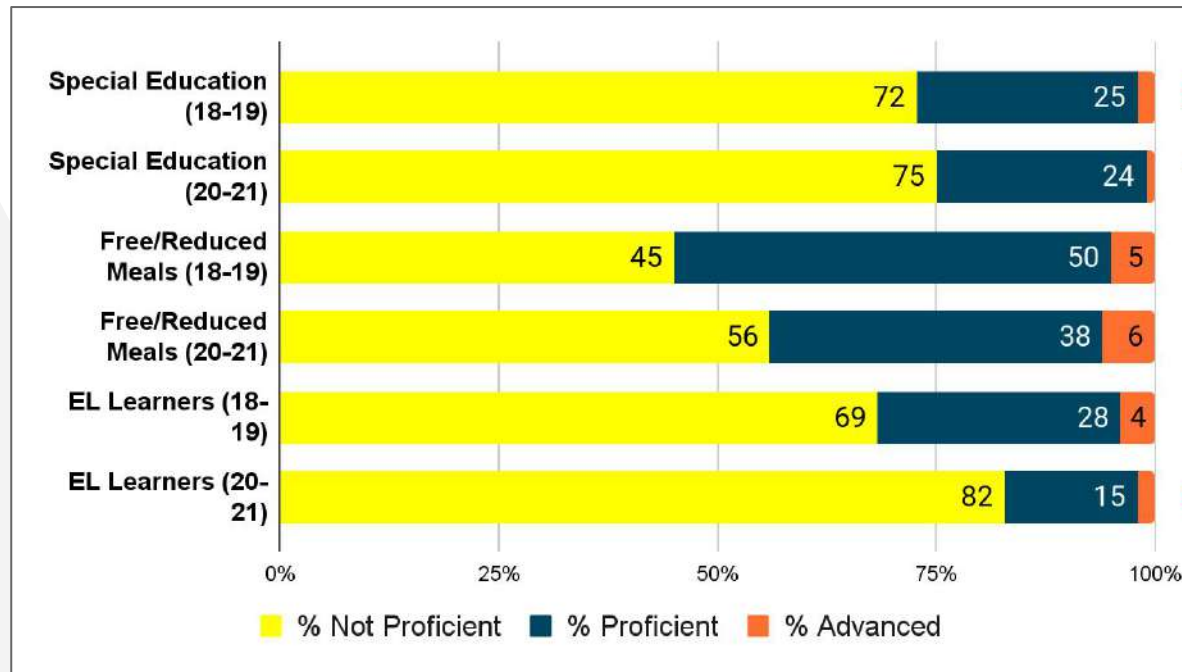

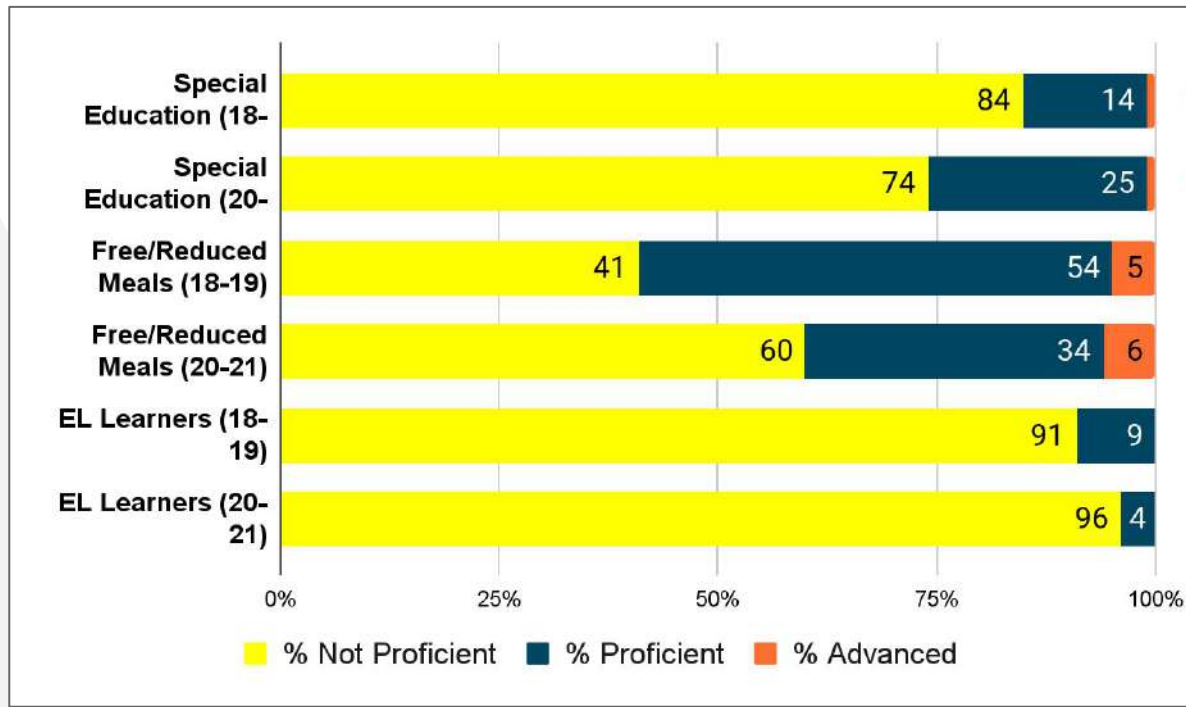
