Do not obstruct other audience member's views

While photographing or filming your child perform, please be sure you do not excessively block other's view of the performance.

Stay for the complete concert

Nothing's worse than seeing empty seats! Please be sure to stay for the whole program. We encourage our performers to stay and enjoy their peer's hard work!

Do not leave in the middle of a performance.

We understand emergencies happen. IF you have to LEAVE/ENTER the auditorium, please only do so in between songs, so you do not distract the performers on stage.




