Issue Web Site

Select a community or national issue that is important to you. Create a one page Web site that tells other teens about the issue, and let them know what actions they can take to become more involved.

- 1. Plan the site's content. Research the issue, try to locate different perspectives on the issue, and identify possible solutions.
- 2. Create your page, include:
 - a. Summary of your research
 - b. List of steps needed to address the issue
 - c. Links to sites related to the issue
- 3. Select appropriate background and font color. Add a graphic or border and section headings for example, summary of the issue, steps to address the issue, and learn more about the issue.
- 4. Evaluate your page. Add or make changes to improve the page. Spell check and proofread the page.
- 5. Submit for grading.
