

Proposal

My proposal today is sparked by the College and Career Readiness Curriculum

Policy Examined: Policy IGB

Graduation Requirement: 1 Credit for CCR

(CCR Curriculum - Unit 3: College Selection and Transition)

College and Career Education:

 Mastery Prep courses are efficient, and so standards should be more heavily implemented considering the impact ACT scores and Dual Credit hours have on aid and scholarships

Proposal: JPS should implement an earlier and consistent use of Mastery Prep enrichment in course offerings starting in 9th grade along with an annual ACT Test to track student progress.





Evidence

Initial Hypothesis: More focused and early implementation of Mastery Prep in the 9th-grade will increase and benefit a student's access to the real world, reflecting the knowledge and skills needed for success in college, career, and to compete in a global economy.
