THE JAMES DAVID DOZIER, III MEOMRIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The James David Dozier, III Memorial Scholarship was established in January 2003 in memory of James D. Dozier, III to annually recognize and assist through the award of a scholarship a member of the graduating class of Marion High School. The scholarship may be used in an accredited postsecondary institution, either a two-year or four-year school, college, or university and will be made payable to the recipient and the postsecondary school of the awardee's choice.

The James David Dozier, III Memorial Scholarship Program will award a minimum of \$500 each year in scholarship funds. The award is made for one year's study only and is not renewable.

Eligible seniors may apply for the scholarship through the guidance office at Marion High School using the application provided. Completed applications must be returned to the guidance office no later than March 1 each year.

All applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee appointed by James David Dozier III's family and made up of the following persons:

- Parents of James David Dozier, III or their designee
- · Justin Dozier
- Superintendent or his/her designee
- Marion High School
- · Marion High School Guidance Counselor
- Community Member (chosen by family)

(Note: The family has the prerogative of changing the committee membership at anytime.)

The scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the annual Marion High School Awards Day.

A scholarship recipient and a first alternate will be selected by the scholarship committee, based on the following criteria:

- Academic merit (minimum C+ average, equivalent to 2.5 on 4.0 grading scale)
- Must have been in attendance at Marion High School for a minimum of two consecutive years
- Character and service to the community with special emphasis on character and love of nature and the outdoors (i.e. hunting, fishing, involvement in wildlife organizations, outdoors activities)
- Involvement in athletics with an earned letter in at least one varsity sport
- Overall quality of applicant's responses to essay questions
