# WINTER CLOTHING GUIDELINES



**In an effort to keep our kids warm and dry during winter recesses, all students are expected to bring boots and snow pants to school. Please see the following winter clothing guidelines that will be enforced during recess times.**

- ❖ **Students who do not have snow pants or boots will be prompted to stay on a clear sidewalk patch during recess unless the blacktop is dry. This is to keep their clothing, shoes, and classroom carpets dry.**
- ❖ **Students who have boots but not snow pants can go on the black top if it is plowed or wet.**
- ❖ **If the playground or blacktop area is dry, students may go there with or without boots.**

# INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



## IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

In a shelter



In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation



In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station



Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

*Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.*

### Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
  - Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
  - Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
  - Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
- \* If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
  - Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

*If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.*
