- I. FY18 Financial Update
 - Revenue Update
 - 1. YTD \$2,698,387, which is \$226,934 more than last year at this time
 - 2. We have received 34.7% of our budget compared to last year at 33.0%
 - 3. Primary contributor is the increase in property tax revenue received due to the new voter approved operating referendum passed
 - 4. Federal will increase as Title Draws & Federal Sub-Awards are reimbursed
 - Expense Update
 - 1. YTD \$3,109,581 which is \$136,572 higher than last year at this time
 - 2. Salaries and benefits are up, as the retro payment from settlement is processed
 - 3. Dues & Memberships up slightly in the Other Exp Category
- II. FY18 Revised Budget Timeline
 - January
 - 1. For revenue, we are going to use the latest student numbers in combination with an average of all the prior months with administrative input
 - 2. Finalizing the expense side with the settlement and more concrete expenses
 - 3. Reviewed on Tuesday (1/16) with administration for final polishing
 - 4. Reviewing Fund 06 with Laurie at Unesco on 1/25/18
 - February
- 1. Bringing to School Board for Approval
- III. FY19 Adopted Budget Timeline
 - January February
 - 1. Work on Capital Project List a rough FY19 estimate has been established
 - 2. Will work with the budget model for enrollment to see where finances are trending
 - March April
 - 1. Continued budget discussions on any changes that need to be made to expense and/or revenue and enrollment
 - May-June
 - 1. Board Approval
