





**Most rewarding part of being a teacher:** Hearing my students go "Oh!" when they understand a concept.


Name of your 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher: Ms. Wagoner (she was my all time favorite teacher)


Volunteer Spotlight for January

## American Girl Night


### American Girl®
