Specific Scholarships

- **GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program:** This nationwide scholarship is worth \$40,000 over 4 years, and it is for seniors that meet the following criteria:
 1. Demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship
 2. Demonstrate strong academic performance (min. 3.0 grade point average/4.0 scale)
 3. Demonstrate financial need
 4. Are citizens of the United States of America
 5. Are high school seniors attending high school in the United States
 6. Plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study toward a bachelor's degree at an accredited four-year college or university in the US for the entire 2024-25 academic year.

- **National FFA Organization Scholarships:** These scholarships are for seniors that are planning to pursue a degree in an Agriculture field. For more information or to apply, visit: FFA.org/scholarships.
The application deadline to apply is January 11, 2024.
- **Ohio Township Association Scholarship:** Five (5) scholarships valued at \$1,500 are available to graduating seniors living in an Ohio township (3.0 cumulative GPA or higher) with plans to attend a university, training program, or vocational school in Ohio. For more information or to apply, visit: <https://www.ohiotownships.org/scholarship-program>. **The application deadline is January 31, 2024.**
- **Indiana University East-High School Counselor's Scholarship Program:** These scholarships are for seniors that plan to attend Indiana University East. The value of these scholarships ranges from \$7,000 to \$34,000 (Full Tuition Scholarship). The amount of the scholarship depends upon the student's GPA and ACT scores (the \$7,000 scholarship doesn't require an ACT score). These scholarships do not require a separate scholarship application or essay. Interested students need to complete the IU East application process and inform Mr. Sutter about their interest in this scholarship before February 15, 2023. **See Mr. Sutter about these scholarships before February 15, 2024.**

- Judy & Neil Stemley Scholarship:** This \$2,500 renewable scholarship will be awarded to two high school seniors from Ansonia High School or St. Henry High School that are planning on attending Ohio State University and pursuing a degree in Food Science (College of Ag) or Special Education. Students must demonstrate leadership and the potential to make a positive impact in their field. Students that are admitted to Ohio State and designate Food Science and Technology, Food Business Management, or Culinary Science as their major are automatically considered for the Judy & Neil Stemley Scholarship. Please note: Priority consideration is given to students who submit the scholarship application by February 15, 2024.**
- Darke Rural Electric Scholarship:** Five (5) scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$2,000 will be awarded to graduating high school seniors, whose parents are members of Darke Rural Electric Cooperative. - 2024 Midmark Technical Scholarships:** Midmark Corporation is offering five (5) scholarships ranging from \$2,500 to \$10,000 and paid co-ops to graduating high school seniors from Darke, Miami, Mercer, Auglaize, or Shelby county high schools. Applicants must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and be pursuing a bachelor's degree in:
 - Mechanical engineering
 - Electrical engineering
 - Software engineering
 - Industrial engineering
 - Computer engineering, Computer Information Systems, or Computer Science

- Edison State Community College Scholarships:** Edison State Community College offers approximately 35+ scholarships each year to qualifying students. Only fill out one application to be considered for any of these opportunities. The scholarship amounts range from \$200 to full-tuition scholarships. - Wayne Healthcare Foundation Scholarship:** Multiple \$1,000 scholarships are available to Darke County graduating seniors that are continuing their education in human health science or medical science. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and must demonstrate strong educational goals as well as strong extra-curricular activities, school citizenship, and leadership. - **Business Professional Women's (BPW) Scholarships:** Eight (8) \$ 1,000.00 BPW Scholarships and one (1) \$500.00 Anna Brittan Scholarship will be awarded to female seniors (Class of 2024).
 - The BPW Scholarships are available to all Darke County female high school seniors of the 2024 graduating class who are ranked in the upper one third of her graduating class.
 - The Anna Britton Scholarship is available to any daughter or granddaughter of a current active BPW member (Please place your Mother or Grandmother's name in the space provided in the application, if applicable).

All applications must include a copy of your high school transcripts, two (2) references, one from an educator and one from non-educator and who is not a relative. Additional page(s) may be included for all your awards and honors received. Scholarship money will be sent to the recipient's educational institution. The scholarship application is posted on the guidance webpage. - **Wright State University Lake Campus-WOEF Foundation Scholarships:** These scholarships of varying amounts are for seniors that have been admitted to Wright State University Lake Campus. Students interested in applying for these scholarships must be admitted in order to have access to the WOEF Scholarship application. - **Ohio Natural Energy Foundation 2024 Scholarship:** This \$1,000 statewide scholarship (potentially renewable) is for seniors that are interested in pursuing a career in the natural gas or oil industry (lawyer, diesel mechanic, engineer, welder, etc.). - **Universal 1 Credit Union's 2024 Glen R Kershner Memorial Scholarship:** This \$1,000 scholarship is available to graduating seniors that are considering post-secondary education at an accredited college or university. Also, applicants must have an immediate family member that is a Universal 1 Credit Union member. - **Rumpke Darke County Scholarship:** This \$2,500 scholarship is for seniors in Darke County that plan to pursue a two or four-year degree at an accredited institution, including vocational/trade schools. The scholarship application is posted on the guidance webpage. **The application deadline is March 8, 2024.**
- **Whirlpool Corporation Wind Farm Scholarship:** Three (3) scholarships worth \$5,000 each are available to local graduating seniors (attending school in Darke, Preble, Miami, Montgomery, Mercer, Shelby, Auglaize, Greene, Randolph, and Wayne counties) that have plans to complete a college education in a science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM) discipline at an accredited school. - **Horatio Alger Association Scholarships:** Over 600 national scholarships, worth up to \$25,000, are meant to assist high school students who have faced and overcome great obstacles in their young lives. Applicants should exhibit determination, integrity, and perseverance in overcoming adversity, as well as have critical financial need. - **Darke County Retired Teachers Association (DCRTA) Scholarship:** Two (2) scholarships valued at \$500 each are available to Darke County graduating seniors that are planning to pursue a bachelor's degree in education. The scholarship application is posted on the guidance webpage. **Applications must be submitted by March 31, 2024.**
- **R & D Liette Charitable Trust Scholarship:** This \$2,000 scholarship is available to Ansonia graduating seniors who are continuing their education at a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university. Applicants must plan to major in a science, engineering, technical, or mathematics field. Applicants must also have a 3.2 cumulative GPA during high school to be eligible. The scholarship application is posted on the guidance webpage. **Completed applications must be submitted by April 1, 2024.**
- **Access Engineering Solutions, LLC Scholarship (Celina, Ohio):** One (1) \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior (Class of 2024). Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree at a four year university, two year college and/or a technical school in the field of Civil Engineering or Surveying, or a related field of study. The scholarship application is posted on the guidance webpage. Completed applications must be emailed to nkt@accessengllc.com. **Completed applications must be submitted by April 1, 2024.**
- **Callie's Giving Heart Foundation Scholarship:** Two (2) local scholarships are valued at \$1,000, and they are available to senior applicants residing in Darke, Mercer, Shelby, Auglaize, or Miami County, Ohio, pursuing higher education within the medical field. - **Lariat Future Innovators Foundation STEM Scholarship:** This scholarship, worth up to \$30,000 over 4 years, is available to graduating seniors and college students (age 18-24) who are pursuing degrees in science, technology, engineering, and math. To be eligible, students should be from a small town (fewer than 25,000) and have a family household income of \$55,000 or less. Students should also have a 3.5 cumulative GPA or higher and be able to demonstrate your passion for STEM (excelling in projects, winning science/math awards, etc.).
