Lisa Cockayne Memorial Scholarship – for the benefit of JMHS students!

Amount: \$3,000

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from John Marshall High School

Bradley Miller Jr. Memorial Scholarship – for the benefit of JMHS students!

Amount: \$1,000 (Awarded in the second semester pending adequate academic progress)

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from John Marshall High School
- Must have maintained a 3.0 GPA
- Applicant must exhibit financial need

Howard Corcoran Memorial Scholarship

Amount: Awards and amounts will vary.

Eligibility:

- Student must attend an OVAC school located in West Virginia, but athletic involvement is not required
- Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at the time of application
- Student must plan to enroll in a two-year or four-year college or university following graduation
- Student must demonstrate a significant contribution to his or her community through volunteering or other types of community service

Ken Dennis Scholarship

Amount: Determined annually.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of an Ohio Valley high school, with preference given to Martins Ferry High School students
- Must pursue a degree in mathematics, science, or engineering
- Preference will be given to students pursuing a degree from Miami University (Ohio) or The Ohio State University

Mulholland Futures Scholarship

Amount: Award varies

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a youth from West Virginia pursuing any type of post-high school education (degree, licensure, certification)
- Applicant must be a current graduating senior or have obtained a high school diploma or GED/TASC within previous five years
- Preference extended to a youth in recent care at Youth Services Systems, Inc. (within previous five years), a youth of a current YSS employee

Preference extended to applicants from the northern panhandle of West Virginia (Hancock, Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Tyler or Wetzel counties)

Orrick, Herrington, Sutcliffe GOC Scholarship

Amount: Award varies.

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from an Ohio Valley high school
- Must have maintained a 3.5 GPA
- Applicant must plan to major in a business field – emphasis on business management, accounting, or information technology

Polish American Patriot Club Scholarship

Amount: Award varies (multiple awards)

Eligibility:

- Must be a resident of Ohio or Marshall County in West Virginia or Belmont County in Ohio
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have maintained a 3.0 GPA

Jerome B. Schmitt Memorial Scholarship

Amount: Award varies

Eligibility:

- Must have graduated from a high school community in which there is a WesBanco Branch
- Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA
- Applicant must attend West Liberty University, majoring in a degree from the School of Business
- Applicant must exhibit financial need

John H. & Dorothy M. Zmavec Scholarship

Amount: Award varies. The scholarship will be awarded to one female and one male student.

Eligibility:

- Must have graduated from a high school in Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Wetzel or Tyler counties in West Virginia or Belmont or Jefferson counties in Ohio
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Applicant must plan to major in education (primary/secondary)
- Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA
- Scholarship awarded based on financial need, grades, and involvement in extracurricular activities

The Warren, Mary & Debbie Bennett Scholarship – New Scholarship for 2019!

Amount: \$2,000, number of awards may vary

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating high school senior or enrolled college student from the tri-state area with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, trade school or certificate program
- Preference will be given to applicants who are current, baptized members of a Church of Christ located in the tri-state area
- For the purposes of this scholarship, tri-state area is defined as areas of West Virginia, Ohio and Pennsylvania generally considered to be located within a reasonable distance from Weirton, WV

The following funds are held at CFOV, but the affiliated scholarship opportunities operate outside of the December 1- March 1 cycle.

John Marshall High School Scholarships

Amount: Determined Annually – Multiple Awards

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from John Marshall High School
 - Applicant must exhibit financial need, academic achievement, and commitment to school and community
- Inquire with your guidance counselor for application information*

Upper Ohio Valley Italian Foundation Scholarship

Amount: Award varies (multiple awards)

Eligibility:

- Must be a resident of Hancock, Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Tyler or Wetzel counties in West Virginia or Belmont or Jefferson counties in Ohio
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA; minimum ACT composite score of 18 and/or a total SAT of 800
- Scholarship awarded based on character, leadership, academics, community services, financial need, and participation in school activities

Rachael Worby Scholarship

Amount: Award varies (multiple awards)

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from the Upper Ohio Valley or a participant in Wheeling Symphony Youth Orchestra for at least two years
- Applicant must pursue a degree in music in the fall following high school graduation
Inquire with the Wheeling Symphony for application information

The following CFOV opportunity is for students with 30 college credit hours and a minimum collegiate GPA of 2.2 (with a collegiate transcript) – there have been instances where graduating seniors have been eligible for this opportunity due to enrollment in dual-credit programming, etc.

AAUW Beulah Boyd Scholarship

Amount: Determined Annually

Eligibility:

- Applicant must have completed 30 credit hours of college courses, with a minimum GPA of 2.2
- Must reside in Brooke, Ohio, or Marshall counties in West Virginia or Belmont County, Ohio
